### ***Scripture Reading: Exodus 20:1-17 (p. 61)***

<sup>1</sup> And God spoke all these words, saying, <sup>2</sup>“I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery.

<sup>3</sup>“You shall have no other gods before me. <sup>4</sup>“You shall not make for yourself a carved image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth. <sup>5</sup>You shall not bow down to them or serve them, for I the Lord your God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children to the third and the fourth generation of those who hate me, <sup>6</sup>but showing steadfast love to thousands of those who love me and keep my commandments.

<sup>7</sup>“You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain, for the Lord will not hold him guiltless who takes his name in vain. <sup>8</sup>“Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy. <sup>9</sup>Six days you shall labor, and do all your work, <sup>10</sup>but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the Lord your God. On it you shall not do any work, you, or your son, or your daughter, your male servant, or your female servant, or your livestock, or the sojourner who is within your gates. <sup>11</sup>For in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea, and all

that is in them, and rested on the seventh day. Therefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.

### **God Speaks To Us**

***“Free At Last”  
Galatians 5:1-15 (p. 974, 975)  
Barry Noll***

<sup>1</sup> For freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery.

<sup>2</sup> Look: I, Paul, say to you that if you accept circumcision, Christ will be of no advantage to you. <sup>3</sup> I testify again to every man who accepts circumcision that he is obligated to keep the whole law. <sup>4</sup> You are severed from Christ, you who would be justified by the law; you have fallen away from grace. <sup>5</sup> For through the Spirit, by faith, we ourselves eagerly wait for the hope of righteousness. <sup>6</sup> For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision counts for anything, but only faith working through love.

<sup>7</sup> You were running well. Who hindered you from obeying the truth? <sup>8</sup> This persuasion is not from him who calls you. <sup>9</sup> A little leaven leavens the whole lump. <sup>10</sup> I have confidence in the Lord that you will take no other view, and the one who is troubling you will bear the penalty, whoever he is. <sup>11</sup> But if I, brothers, still preach circumcision, why am I still being persecuted? In that case the offense of the cross has been removed. <sup>12</sup> I wish those who unsettle you would emasculate themselves!

<sup>13</sup> For you were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another. <sup>14</sup> For the whole law is fulfilled in one word: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." <sup>15</sup> But if you bite and devour one another, watch out that you are not consumed by one another.

### ***For Further Discussion:***

1. What freedom are the Galatians in danger of losing (vs. 1)? How can you stand firm for freedom in your own walk with Christ?
2. How does legalistic observance of the law sever you from the grace of Christ (vv. 2-4; Gal. 2:21; 3:10)? When in your life have you tended to lean on your religious performance or personal accomplishments for salvation?
3. What other righteousness are you tempted to count on for your justification before God instead of Christ (vv. 5-6)? How is your faith working through love to God, your spouse, your children, your neighbors, and coworkers (vs. 6; cf. Jn. 6: 28-29)?
4. How are the false teachers persecuting Paul and the Galatians (vv. 7-12; Gal. 4:29; 6:12)? Why is the cross so offensive to religious people (vs. 11; 1 Cor. 1: 18-24; 1 Pt. 2:8)?
5. What does Paul say prevents you from using your freedom in Christ to indulge your flesh (vv. 13-15, 22, Lev. 19:18; Gal. 6:2)? How does the grace train you to say no to ungodliness and worldly passions (Titus 2:11-12)?
