Hillside Kids 2023-2024

Hello Parents!

We are excited to share important information about Hillside Big Kids for 2023-2024!

Hillside Big Kids is Henderson Hills' ministry to kindergarten through 5th grade. On Sundays, we offer Community Groups for children to help them grow closer to God and each other. Our Community Groups consist of small group time where kids do activities related to the Bible story, along with practical applications to use throughout the week. Children will also participate in a large group time where they worship God through singing and hear the Bible story for the week. The curriculum we use on Sunday mornings is from The Gospel Project for Kids. The Gospel Project follows a chronological timeline of events over three years designed to teach kids that the Bible is one story – God's story. It is a story of redemption through Jesus Christ and how He fits into every part of God's big plan, from before creation to eternity. Every week, children will learn how they are also part of His plan.

While kids are a part of Hillside Big Kids, they will learn some fundamental spiritual disciplines such as being in a community with other believers, evangelism, studying God's Word, and memorizing His Word.

In Hillside Kids, we want learning about God to be fun, so one of the ways we have incorporated fun into learning is through our Locker Room. The Locker Room has held a special place in Hillside Kids for a very long time! While the concept of The Locker Room is still the same, the name has changed. You may have noticed in the upstairs area that we have done a refresh of our own! So now The Hideaway Shoppe, will be the new name for the Locker Room.

The Hideaway Shoppe is a 'store' where kids can redeem points earned as they practice and learn spiritual disciplines. Points can be spent on the Sunday following the Sunday they earned points. We encourage parents to work with their children, helping and encouraging them to learn verses, bring their Bible to church, invite friends, and so much more!

We believe all Scripture is inspired by God and able to equip for every good work, and we want to come alongside families in your efforts to train your children to become all God wants them to be. We are grateful that you allow us to be a part of discipling your children.


