

Rules + Policies

Medical: Please let us know if you have any special medical needs. Please make sure it is clear on your medical release form. We will be taking up all medication during check-in and distributing them per doctor's orders or as needed. We cannot allow students to self medicate (Talk to us about special exceptions).

Dress Code: First and foremost we ask students to *dress modestly* in order to honor God first and honor each other. We want everything we do to be honoring the Lord. There are a few specific things we need to mention:

→ Girls: one-piece swimsuits only. No bikinis or tankinis. Also, no spaghetti straps, open back shirts, tank tops that reveal top and bottom of bra on side, short shorts, or any kind of see-through clothing; Guys – no speedos or white undershirt tank tops

Camp Rules (Partial; complete details will be covered at camp)

- No guys in the girls' dorms or girls in the guys' dorms.
- ❖ No PDA
- Rude, Mean, or Bullying Behavior is NOT tolerated
- Everyone is expected to participate in every scheduled activity (including all meals)
- Cell phones will be allowed on the bus rides only. Once at camp, we will be taking up all cell phones. Henderson Hills will not be responsible for lost, broken or stolen electronics. Bring at your own risk.

Violation of these and other guidelines stated at camp will incur certain necessary disciplines:

- Second Offense: Student Ministry Staff Calls Home
- > Third Offense: Sent Home At Parents Expense

Please be monitoring your student(s) for symptoms of Covid-19 or other viruses. If a student begins showing symptoms at camp we will quarantine them and contact their parents immediately. Please do not send your student to camp with a fever (this includes fevers controlled by medications)
