Catechism:

6. Are there more gods than one?

No. There is only one God.

(Deuteronomy 6:4; Jeremiah 10:10; Mark 12:29; Acts 17:22-31)

7. In how many persons does this one God exist?

In three Persons.

(Matthew 3:16, 17; John 5:23; 10:30; 14:9,10; 15:26; 16:13-15; 1 John 5:20, 2 John 9; Revelation 1:4, 5)

8. Who are these three Persons?

The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

(Matthew 28:19; 1 Corinthians 8:6; 2 Corinthians 13:14; 1 Peter 1:2; Jude 20, 21)

9. Who is God?

God is a Spirit and does not have a body like men.

(John 4:24; 2 Corinthians 3:17; 1 Timothy 1:17)

10. Where is God?

God is everywhere.

(Psalm 139:7-12; Jeremiah 23:23, 24; Acts 17:27, 28)

Catechism:

19. Do you have a soul as well as a body?

Yes. I have a soul that can never die.

(Matthew 10:28; Mark 8:34-38; 12:30)

20. How do you know that you have a soul?

Because the Bible tells me so.

(Matthew 10:28; Mark 8:34-38; 12:30)

21. In what condition did God create Adam and Eve?

He made them holy and happy.

(Genesis 1:26-28; Palm 8:4-8)

22. Did Adam and Eve stay holy and happy?

No. They sinned against God.

(Genesis 3:1-7; Ecclesiastes 7:29; Hosea 6:7 where “men” = Adam)

23. What is sin?

Sin is being, desiring, or doing anything against God’s perfect moral law.

(1 John 3:4; Romans 3:20; James 2:9-11)

24. Are you a sinner?

Yes. I am a sinner. Everyone is a sinner except Jesus.

(Romans 3:9-20; Romans 3:23)

(Exodus 20:1-17; Deuteronomy 5:1-22)

65. What are the Ten Commandments sometimes called?

God’s moral law.

(Luke 20:25-28; Romans 2:14, 15; 10:5)

66. What do the first four commandments teach?

Our duty to God.

(Deuteronomy 6:5, 6; 10:12, 13)

67. What do the last six commandments teach?

Our duty to our fellow men and women.

(Deuteronomy 10:19; Micah 6:8; Galatians 6:10)

Catechism:

115. How can we know the word of God?

We are commanded to hear, read, and search the Scriptures.

(Matthew 21:42; 22:29; 2 Timothy 3:14-17; 1 Peter 2:2; Revelation 3:22)

116. What is a church?

An assembly of baptized believers met together under the preaching of the word of God.

(Matthew 18:20; Acts 2:42)

117. What two ordinances did Christ give to His Church?

Baptism and the Lord’s Supper

(Matthew 28:19; 1 Corinthians 11:24-26)

118. Why did Christ give these ordinances?

To show that His disciples belong to Him, and to remind them of what He has done for them.

(Matthew 28:19; 1 Corinthians 11:24-26)

119. What is baptism?

The immersion of believers in water, as a sign of their union with Christ in His death, burial, and resurrection.

(John 3:23; Acts 2:41; 8:12, 35-38; Colossians 2:12)

Catechism:

41. What will be done to the wicked at the day of judgment?

At the day of judgment, the wicked being raised to dishonor, will be sentenced to the unspeakable torments of body and soul in hell with the devil and his angels for all eternity. (Daniel 12:2; Matthew 13:49-50; 25:41, 46; John 5:28-29; 2 Thessalonians 1:8-9; Revelation 14:10-11).

42. What is the duty which God requires of man?

The duty which God requires of man is obedience to His revealed will. (Ecclesiastes 12:13-14; Micah 6:8)

43. What did God at first reveal to man for the rule of his obedience?

The rule which God at first revealed to man for his obedience was the moral law. (Romans 2:14-15)

44. What is the summary of the moral law?

The Ten Commandments.

45. What is the sum of the Ten Commandments?

The sum of the Ten Commandments is, to love the Lord our God with all our heart, with all our soul, with all our strength and with all our mind; and our neighbor as ourselves. (Matthew 22:37-40)

46. What is the preface to the Ten Commandments?

The preface to the Ten Commandments is in these words, “I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage.” (Exodus 20:2)
