Corporate Confession of Sin

O God, you demonstrated your love for us in that while we were sinners, Christ died for us. And while we were your enemies you reconciled us to yourself by the death of your son and have saved us by his life. We have sinned against you and against one another. We confess that we have not always used sober judgement but have thought more highly of ourselves than we ought. We have not regularly benefited one another with those gifts you gave us; or we have exercised those gifts only for ourselves. With the tax collector we bow our heads and beat our breasts, saying: God, be merciful to me, a sinner! Amen.
