Hope Has a Mission (Mark 1:16 – 45)

He (Jesus) gave His Life for us, to give His Life to us, so He could share His Life through us. – Pastor Nate Murray

1. What is your new Sunday morning routine during this “stay at home”? Are you anxious to return to “Life before COVID” or could you settle in to your new routine?
2. Pastor Dan said; Encountering hope can change your life. It can also change the life of someone around us. Discuss ways you can offer hope and encouragement to others and/or share how something you’ve said or done that has encouraged HOPE in someone.
3. Read the calling of the first disciples in Mark 1:14-20. How soon after Jesus called to them did they respond? How soon after you receive a prompting by the Holy Spirit do you respond? What reasons might you give for your hesitation?
4. Mark tells us that very early in the morning while it was still dark Jesus got up and went to a solitary place where He prayed. What two things in that sentence draw your attention? Why do you think it is important to get our “daily” mission correct?
5. Even Jesus recognized He had not come to heal or provide every need for all the people in Capernaum. His stated mission was to preach the Good News. What mission do you think God has placed on you? How might you act on it this week?
