FAITH Series - Not Applauded Yet Rewarded

*Faith is not just having a stronger "no," we also need a better "yes."
Keep chasing the greater reward of heaven & the glory of God. -Pastor Dan*

1. Recall a time when you offered someone a reward for completing a simple task. Share the details. Who did you offer it to and what was their response?
2. Hebrews 11:6 says... "without faith it is impossible to please God...". How would you relate this verse to John 3:16?
3. Moses felt he wasn't good enough, and Rahab had a checkered past, yet through faith they were able to further God's kingdom. Read Hebrews 11:30-31, Joshua 2:1-21, and Joshua 6:15-25. Why do you think God chose Rahab rather than a king, a rabbi, or a city official to carry out His will? Who is someone you know that God is using to further His kingdom today?
4. Pastor Dan stated, "Your past does not have to define your destiny" and C.S. Lewis wrote, "You can't go back and change the beginning, but you can start where you are and change the ending." How can **your faith in Jesus** affect how you make decisions that will impact your eternal destiny?
5. It can be difficult to keep our focus on God's future rewards while we're bombarded with the fleeting pleasures of this world. As "iron sharpens iron," how can you also sharpen and encourage others in their walk with the Lord?
