KEY FIGURE: MOSES

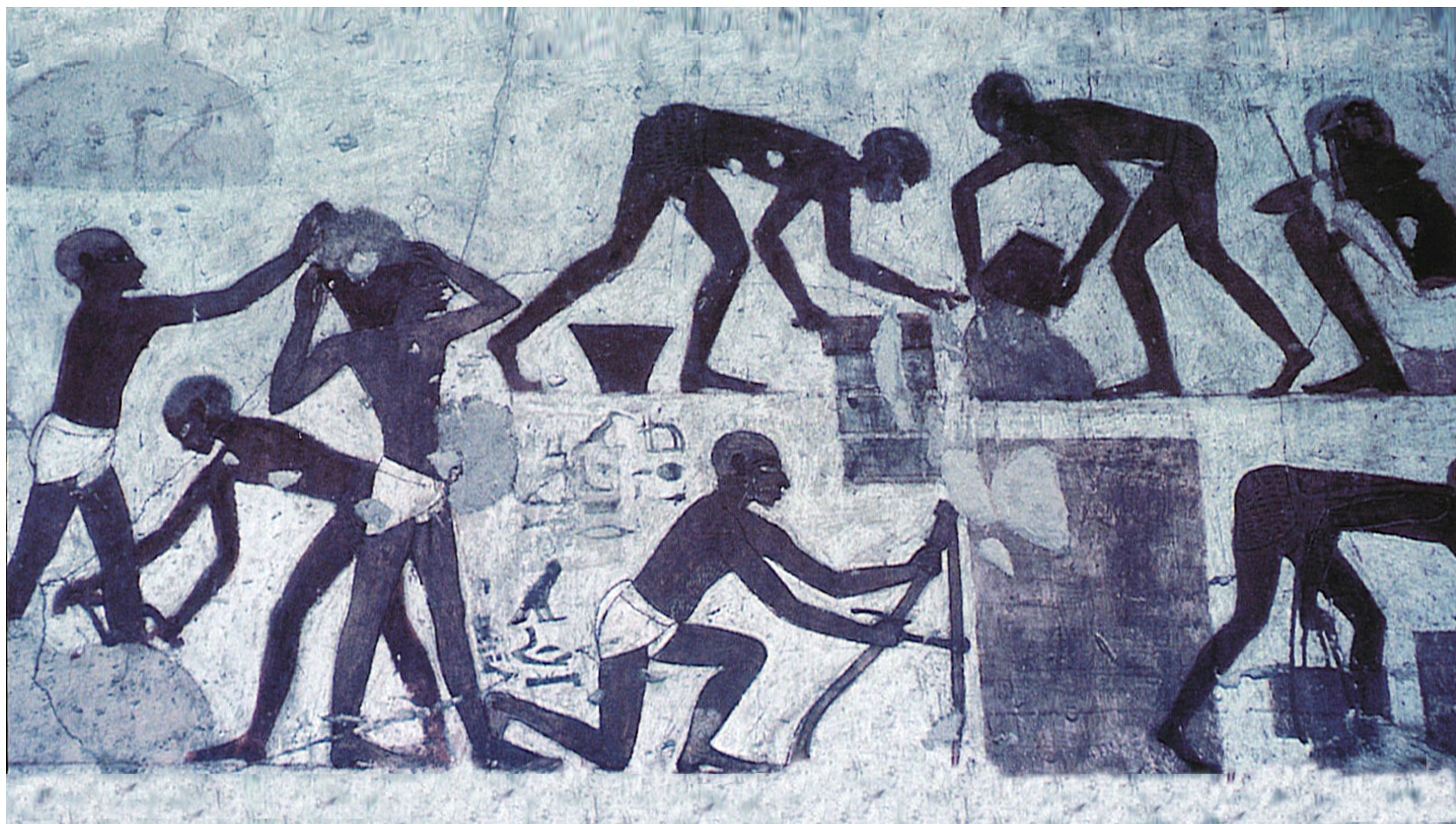
Through Moses, God delivers the Hebrew people from slavery in Egypt and then gives them the law.

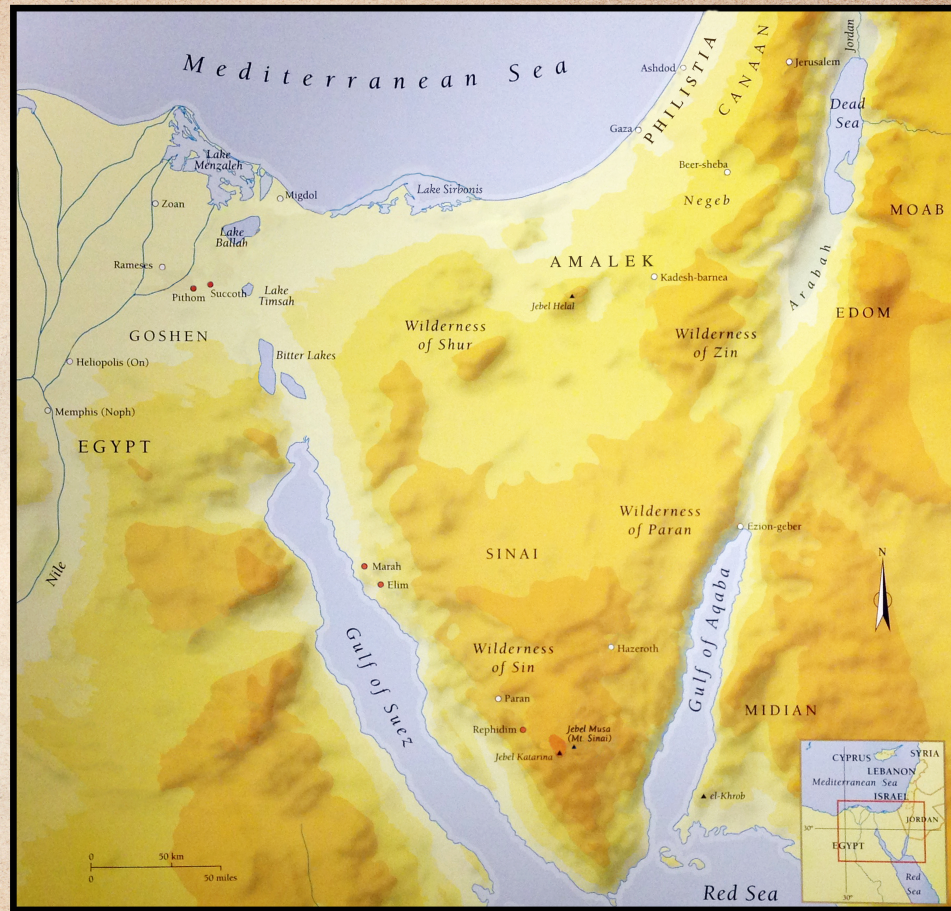

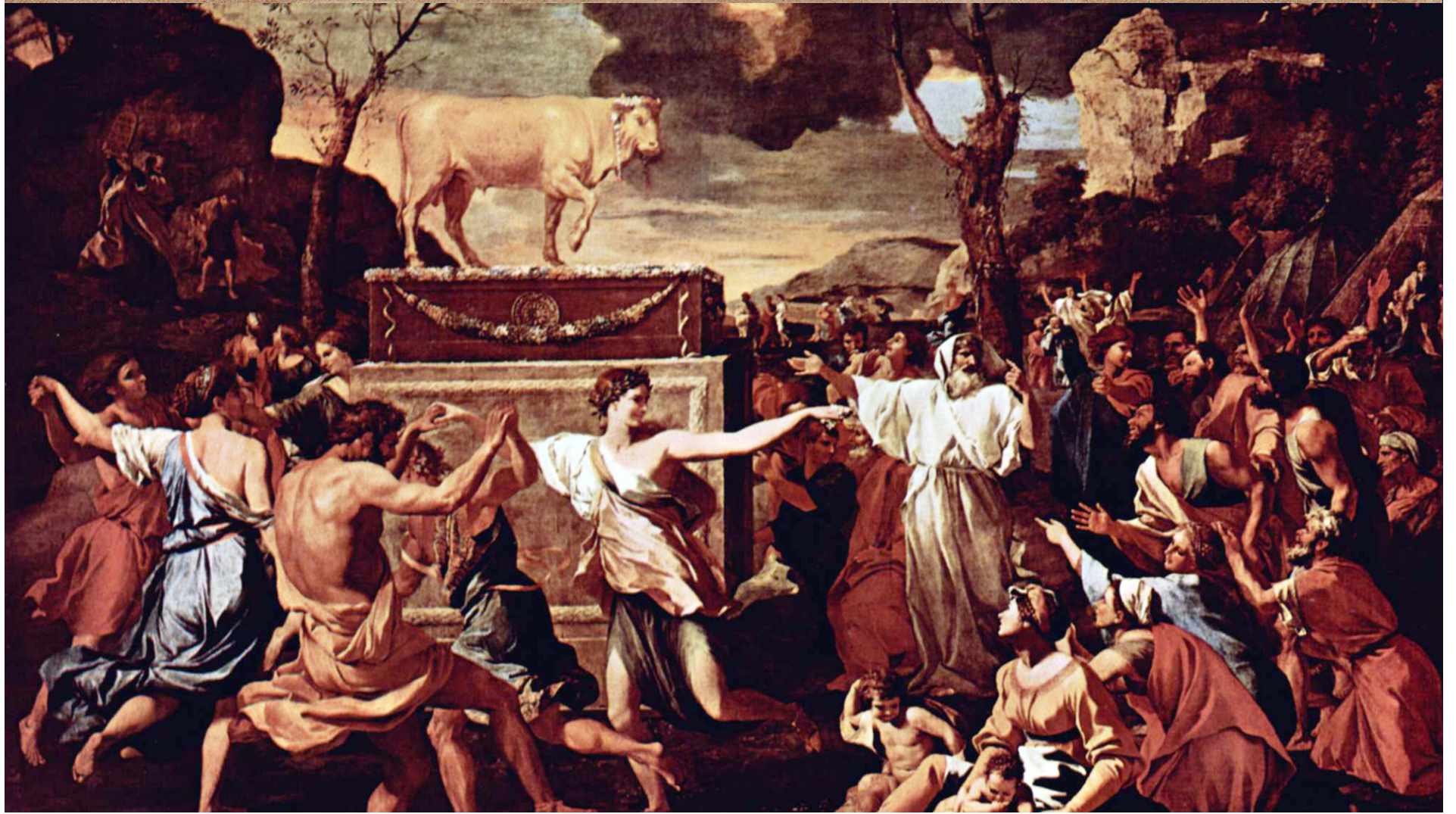

(*Numbers 10-14*)



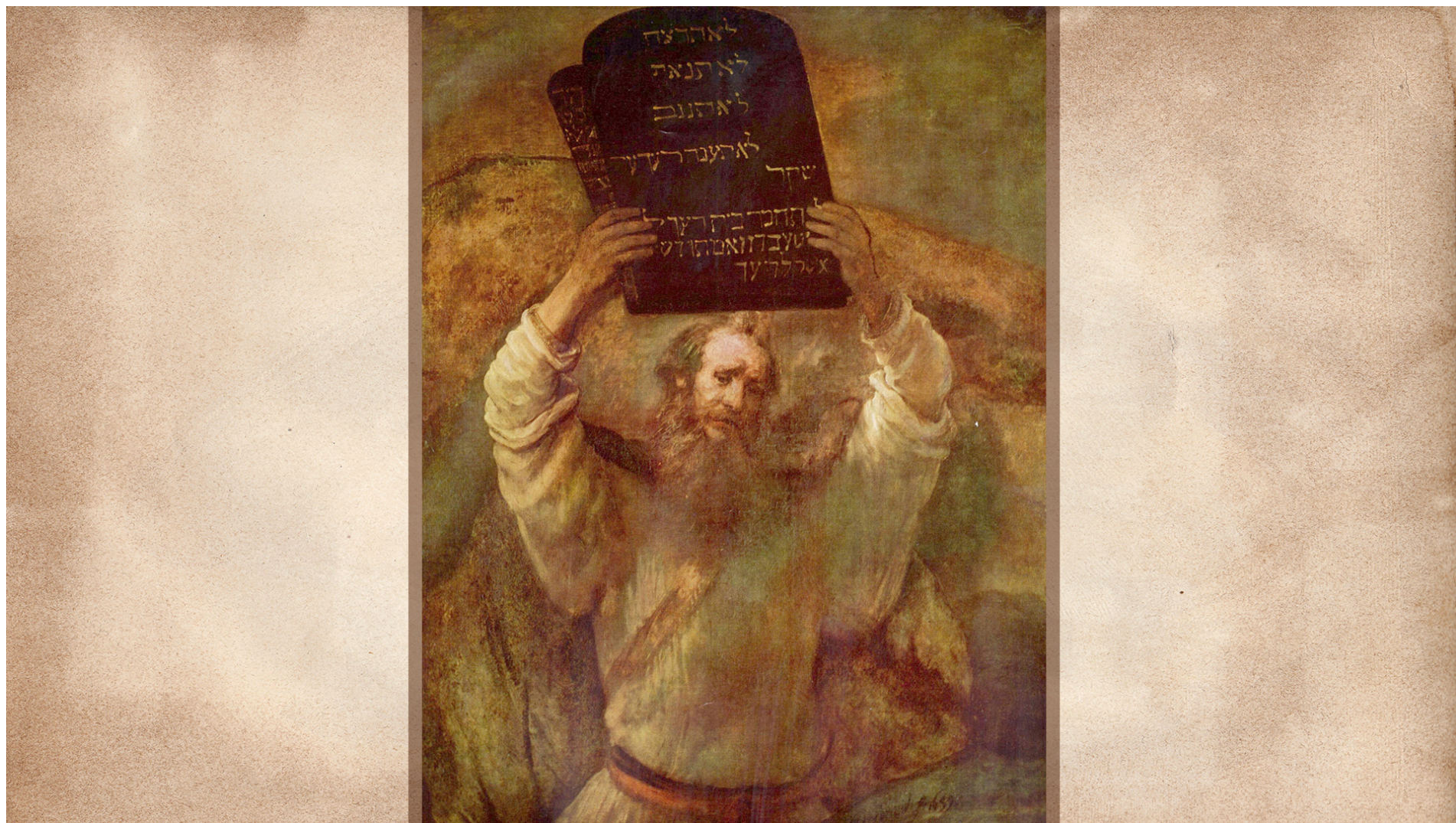
