We have to reorganize ourselves to do what God wants us to do not what we want to do.

We were program driven and in decline. We need to change our heart to a heart of service and help. We need to have a passion for the world. We want to make a change. We need to bring more people in.

You can have a change and push yourself is how you stay on the incline. You must look to the future and imagine what can be. Don't get stuck in the program~this is what we do.

You are working with people who are outside the doors of the church. It is your personal community. Are we about the people in the circle we are in?

Innovation is the norm. You are willing to try new things.

Committed to following God no matter what. We move even when it doesn't make sense. WE are called to serve and the gifts are for others not you. Identify the gifts!! Invent more spaces for people to work in. We need to be on the conversion train. We need to minister to those who are not saved.

God has a reason for putting this church in the place where it is.

Let's make the extraordinary ordinary in the body of Christ. We want to by the grace of God make things happen!

Virilization is ongoing. We have to use this point as a launch pad for a new destination. We will be intentional in launching a new life cycle where we are. We are continuing to start a new season. We will reevaluate and then relaunch. Make adjustments as a choice and not a response to a crises.

Assimilation of new people into the heart of the church and allows you to see and hear the vision of the church and where we are going.

Logic of proximity: easier for a newcomer to come. Contagion reaches a handful of people who live nearby. Get 10 people. You can plug the people that are nearby.

Spiritual and strategic.

Always be spiritual and strategic. You need both to be effective. Vision is about discernment. God has a vision for the church and we need to discern what God has for our church.

You structure must specifically support the strategy to reach the vision. It works and when it works more people are drawn to the church. Do not focus on the inward but keep looking at the outward.

When you don't have strategy you fall into programs. You then have tons of structure.

New Vision

Content: Scripture, (non negotiable) Jesus is God's son What we believe

Context: People we are going to reach (demographics)

Containers: How we go (the innovation happens, the creativity come in) negotiable, flexible, favorite and preference

Debra Leaders have to be leaders and the people of God need to sacrifice.

A mature christian is more Self feeding. You are all in!!!! Make your faith known. Coming out of the closet. Culture wants you to keep it to yourself. Don't bring it to work or the gym. We have to allow what we have to be seen and known.

Bible Basic: understand the bible as a whole

Confident in the Bible Acts 2

Basic Bible:

1. In 5 years to know the bible~ relate the old testament to the new testament
2. Bible study to find things and reference (learning should not be overwhelming) {by yourself}
3. Simple Translating

Preemptive Prayer:

1. Have people to pray at the end of the service
2. Pray for people in service before service
3. Praying for the members

Cost Commitment:

1. New to HVPC classes for new member
2. Discipleship / Faith partners
3. Blessings when you go the the cost commitments

Missional Multiplication:

1. Small group
2. Serve the community: soup kitchen, after school program, etc.
3. How can we pray for you
4. Invite people to the community~ to invite them in (You don't have to be Billy Graham. You just take it another notch. Do what you do and add an element to let faith build up.

Reach, Preach, Teach

Go, Make, disciple

To become apart of 2 they usually come from 1. They are worried about the community and not just the inward focus. This church is growing. Page 7-8.

Outreach, evangelisms, discipleship. This is part of the movement, not the committee.

Monthly meetings, worship, train, meet separately then come back together to share what they have done in the meeting.

Vital 180

How do I minister through the congregation? We can move the focus to genting people to minister on the field instead of watching.

Christinity 101

Sharing your faith is important. Sharing the gospel is also important. Get ready to be proactive to be ready to do this thing. Keep it simple and clear. Extended ongoing relationships.
