Graduation Requirements

All students must complete 28 credit hours (TX requires 26 hours) which include four credit hours in Bible beginning freshman year. Students enrolling after freshman year are responsible for one Bible credit per year enrolled. All graduates of ICS must have completed four years each of English, math, science, and social studies.

Graduate Designation

Students are required to follow the Recommended High School Program for the state of Texas which includes one year of a fine art and two years of the

same foreign language. To graduate with a Distinguished Achievement designation, a student must meet the requirements of the Recommended Program plus complete three advanced measures.
