We will guard and uphold the gospel by ministering truth to one another, and affirming faithful, qualified leaders. (Matthew 7:15-20; Galatians 1:8-9; Ephesians 4:15; 1 Timothy 3:15)

We will respect and submit to the pastoral leadership of the church as Christ's own means of shepherding his flock, recognizing that they are keeping watch over your souls, as those who will have to give an account. (1 Thessalonians 5:12-13; Acts 20:28; 1 Peter 5:1-5; Hebrews 13:17)

We will regularly serve, encourage, exhort, pray for and disciple other members of the church to build them up in Christ and help them grow in godliness. (1 Peter 4:10-11; Galatians 5:13; Hebrews 10:24; Colossians 3:16; Hebrews 3:12-13; Ephesians 6:18; Matthew 28:19)

We make all of these commitments knowing that God has ordained our fellowship as a light for the gospel of Jesus Christ. As His ambassadors, we will prayerfully live to make disciples wherever God calls us. (John 13:34-35; John 17:20-23; 2 Corinthians 5:18-20; Ephesians 6:4; Matthew 28:19; Acts 8:4; Colossians 4:5-6; 1 Peter 2:9; 3:15)
