

Here are some questions to consider as you study Revelation 3:14–22 together:

- What does the letter to Laodicea reveal about the character and purposes of Jesus?
- What attitudes among the Laodiceans displeased Jesus?
- What correction does Jesus offer, and what are the consequences if they don't change?
- What does Jesus promise the one who overcomes?
- Read Matthew 6:19–34. Is there a connection between worldliness and lukewarmness?
- Read Matthew 14:44–46. Are there things that you value more than God? Can you share something that took the place of God in your past? What led you into idolatry? How did you overcome worldliness then?
- Read Philippians 4:19–20. Do you believe that God is sufficient for all your needs? How would a believer act if they did not believe God was sufficient?
- What excuses do people often use to not share the gospel? What change of attitude do you think needs to take place in order to become more intentional with our Christian witness?
