**AIDS Care is a ministry focused on children affected by HIV/AIDS.** Currently, the project is active in ten different locations in **northern Thailand** and reaches various people groups, including the Shan. The program supports efforts to help the children stay in their extended families, the majority having lost one or both parents to the disease. Depending on their needs, AIDS Care provides them with daily necessities as well as helping them finish their education. **AIDS Care workers show Christ's love to families through tangible support and care, sharing the gospel while being sensitive to each individual's needs.** AIDS Care also tries to reach the local community with trainings and special events, like Christmas celebrations. Most locations hold a monthly activities morning on Saturdays for the children to hear God's Word and connect with each other and AIDS Care workers. **All families receive regular visits at their homes to ascertain their needs and encourage them in their challenges.** Some of the HIV+ mothers also can earn a fair wage as they make AIDS Care cards from local sa paper (made of mulberry tree bark). The Meisters are in the process of handing over their roles as project managers, but continue to have regular contact with all local leaders and some of the AIDS Care children.
