After our study of selected Psalms, Bible@10 will continue with 2 guidebooks, *Life to the full, John 1-12* and *The place of greatest glory, John 13-21*, both by Josh Moody. John's Gospel is an invitation to you to find life. These 16 studies over 32 weeks will, we pray, not simply give you a deeper understanding of the text, nor a list of practical "to do's", but rather enable you to encounter Jesus the Messiah, the Son of God, more deeply. And that, as you do so, you will find in him, "life" in all the ramifications that John's Gospel intends.

We meet Sundays from 10:00 – 11:00 at IPC, usually in the Reboulet Room (French Church building). Any changes in venue will be announced ahead of the session. Come join us – anytime! And even if you cannot make it every single Sunday, you will still profit from the study and enjoy the group.
