"Who knows but that you have come to royal position for such a time as this?" Esther 4:14 NIV

Esther Shows us What Destiny Looks Like

How can we know God's destiny for our lives? When we study the life of Esther, we find a formula to follow.

- » Esther was an ordinary woman who became a world-changer.
- » An orphan who'd been born into a minority group, she also had a faith different from that of the culture around her.
- » She was a single woman in a distinctly male-dominated society. Anyone would have said that Esther had almost everything going against her.
- » When King Xerxes saw her, he chose her out of all the women in Persia to be his new queen.
- » At the same time, a man named Haman, who was the king's chief of staff, devised a plan to eliminate all the Jews, whom he hated, from the face of the Earth.
- » Esther was a Jew, and her relative Mordecai had become a trusted local official.
- » When Mordecai learned of Haman's plan, he urged Esther to view her place in time, as one given a unique opportunity to step up and save her people.
- » Esther became a woman of destiny. Let's discover what we can learn from her example.





RECOGNIZE THE GIFTS GOD HAS GIVEN ME TO USE

Here's what we learn about Esther, based on Esther 2:8-9, 2:15b, & 2:17:

 \Diamond

» These descriptions give us an idea of Esther's gifts. She was intelligent, attractive, winsome and wise.

- » Esther was limited by her circumstances. Hindsight tells us history would be different had she not had these limitations. God used both the limitations and the gifts he had bestowed on Esther.
- » God used both good and bad circumstances in Esther's life to put her in a unique position to save her people.

What has God given me to use for good?

2 DIDENTIFY THE NEEDS THAT STIR MY HEART

How did Esther react when she heard of the plot to kill the Jews in her kingdom? See Esther 4:4.

- » In the Bible, David was disturbed when he saw the giant Philistine mocking the God of Israel, and he did something about it: He slew that giant. Nehemiah was disturbed when he saw the walls and the people of Jerusalem broken down; that motivated him to start a rebuilding project.
- » Isaiah 58:6-11 names ten awesome blessings that God gives to those who meet the needs of others.

What needs do I see around me that disturb me? How can I use that to motivate me to action?

TAKE TIME TO HEAR GOD'S CALL ON MY LIFE

Mordecai sent this word to Esther: "Do not think that because you are in the king's house you alone of all Jews will escape. For if you remain silent at this time, relief and deliverance for the Jews will arise from another place, but you and your father's family will perish. Besides who knows but that you have come to this position for such a time as this?" Esther 4:13-14 What do I need to put into practice to hear God?

MAKE A FAITH COMMITMENT





The formula: Gifts + Need + Calling= Destiny

Esther modeled all four of these elements. When she realized what she must do, she took a risk. Realizing it could cost her her life, she made a faith commitment. Esther was so committed to her destiny for God, she was ready to die for it. What matters so much to you that you are willing to die for it? Without knowing our destiny, life is just motion without meaning.
