AWAKENING:
Owning up to his true condition

¹ From inside the fish Jonah prayed to the LORD his God. ² He said: "In my distress I called to the LORD, and he answered me. From deep in the realm of the dead I called for help, and you listened to my cry. ³ You hurled me into the depths, into the very heart of the seas, and the currents swirled about me; all your waves and breakers swept over me. Jonah 2:1-3





⁴ I said, 'I have been banished from your sight; yet I will look again toward your holy temple.' 5 The engulfing waters threatened me, the deep surrounded me; seaweed was wrapped around my head. 6 To the roots of the mountains I sank down; the earth beneath barred me in forever. But you, LORD my God, brought my life up from the pit. Jonah 2:4-6



REPENTING:
Releasing idols, laying hold of grace

⁷ "When my life was ebbing away, I remembered you, LORD, and my prayer rose to you, to your holy temple. 8 "Those who cling to worthless idols turn away from God's love for them. 9 But I, with shouts of grateful praise, will sacrifice to you. What I have vowed I will make good. I will say, 'Salvation comes from the LORD.'" Jonah 2:7-9

Jonah Prays

- In desperation, he prays like David: "This poor man called, and the LORD heard him; he saved him out of all his troubles." Psalm 34:6
- In desperation, he prays like Hannah: "In her deep anguish Hannah prayed to the LORD, weeping bitterly." 1 Samuel 1:10
- In desperation, he prays like Jeremiah: "54 the waters closed over my head, and I thought I was about to perish. 55 I called on your name, LORD, from the depths of the pit. ⁵⁶ You heard my plea: "Do not close your ears to my cry for relief." Lamentations 3:54-56
- In desperation, he prays like Jesus: "And being in anguish, he prayed more earnestly, and his sweat was like drops of blood falling to the ground. Luke 22:44
- · In desperation Jonah prays—exactly as God would have us to pray:
- "Is anyone among you in trouble? Let them pray. Is anyone happy? Let them sing songs of praise." James 5:13



The good news is that God does not ask us to change so that we can come to Christ. He invites us to come to Christ so that we can change!
