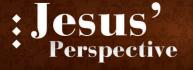
The tongue has the power of life and death, and those who love it will eat its fruit.

# Let's Time to Reframe our » World

## Reframe what others say about you

- We cannot control what others say about us, but we can control what we believe.

Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it. Proverbs 4:23

- It's our responsibility to filter both compliment or criticism.
- We can agree or disagree with the verbal message.
- In the O.T., Jacob became what others said.
- He was described as the "heel-grabber."
- He became the "con-man"; the manipulator; the one who steals other's portions.
- It comes to a head at the brook Jabbok.
- He wrestles with God.
- He learns: you are not what others say you are; you are who God says you are.
