- · Lived about 600 years before Christ
- · Was a contemporary of Jeremiah.
- · His prophecy reads like a personal journal.
- · Habakkuk wants God to explain why the injustice and violence in Judah.
- · God responds with a vision of judgment—the Babylonians will destroy Jerusalem.
- Once the vision is given, Habakkuk is at rest knowing that. The Living God is in control.
