

YOU GET WHAT YOU EXPECT

JOHN 5:1-8 The backstory

The ancient pool of Bethesda was a gathering place for the infirm, the afflicted, and the broken. For 38 years an invalid would go the pool and beg for money. Every once in a while, the waters would be stirred. A superstition grew up around the stirring that it was caused by angels and the first one into the water would be the winner and be healed. This was a false hope based on a false assumption.

The turning point of the story

Jesus asks: "Do you want to get well?" Does that seem a little insulting? He's an invalid. He can't walk—why the guestion?

You have to do the natural hefore God will do the supernatural.

The heart of this story: The invalid only saw one way that he could be healed and it was getting into the water first.

He had this expectation of how he wanted to be healed.

There's a wonderful example of this in 2 Kings 5.

Naaman is a high roller and he shows up with some horses and chariots at the door of Elisha's house. He needs a miracle because he has leprosy.

Elisha sent a messenger to say to him, "Go, wash yourself seven times in the Jordan, and your flesh will be restored and you will be cleansed. 2 Kings 5:10

Naaman is angry and sulking because of his expectations.

But Naaman went away angry and said, "I thought that he would surely come out to me and stand and call on the name of the Lord his God, wave his hand over the spot and cure me of my leprosy. 2 Kings 5:11

That was the only option he saw.

Are not Abana and Pharpar, the rivers of Damascus, better than all the waters of Israel? Couldn't I wash in them and be cleansed?" So he turned and went off in a rage. 2 Kings 5:12

His servants show him otherwise.

Naaman's servants went to him and said, "My father, if the prophet had told you to do some great thing, would you not have done it? How much more, then, when he tells you, 'Wash and be cleansed'!" 2 Kings 5:13

Naaman was willing to alter his expectations.

So he went down and dipped himself in the Jordan seven times, as the man of God had told him, and his flesh was restored and became clean like that of a young boy. 2 Kings 5:14

God wants to sanctify our expectations

I. Begin the day in prayer.

In the morning Lord, You will hear my voice. In the morning, I will lay my requests before you and wait in expectation. Psalm 5:1

2. Get into God's Word.

As you download the Word, it upgrades your operating system. It changes the way you think, believe, and act!

3. Find an expect-ability partner.

Surround yourself with people that have more faith than you do.

4. Don't give up on God.

He's not going to give up on you. He can't. He won't. Sometimes we give up on God.

The miracle requires one assumption:
God is more than able!
