⁷ On the contrary, they recognized that I had been entrusted with the task of preaching the gospel to the uncircumcised, just as Peter had been to the circumcised. ⁸ For God, who was at work in Peter as an apostle to the circumcised, was also at work in me as an apostle to the Gentiles. ⁹ James, Cephas and John, those esteemed as pillars, gave me and Barnabas the right hand of fellowship when they recognized the grace given to me. They agreed that we should go to the Gentiles, and they to the circumcised. ¹⁰ All they asked was that we should continue to remember the poor, the very thing I had been eager to do all along. *Galatians* 2:7-10

LOVE IS A VERB

REKINDLE BURNED-OUT LIVES

He raises the poor from the dust and lifts the needy from the ash heap; he seats them with princes and has them inherit a throne of honor." For the foundations of the earth are the LORD's; on them he has set the world. *1 Samuel 2:8*

OPERATED SET OF THE POOR
