Big Idea: When we reframe what happened in our yesterdays, that changes our todays.



JACOBIN CANAAN

Joseph was born to Jacob & Rachel. He was the favored son.
Jacob made Joseph
a coat of many colors.
Joseph's dreams: sheaves;
sun, moon, and stars.

His brothers sell him to Midianites on their way to Egypt. His brothers dip his coat in goat's blood to make it appear Joseph has vanished.

REFRAMING

Reframing is when we decide we are not going to hang on to old

perceptions that have worked against us. We are going to choose a different, more godly, more productive way of thinking.

For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, declares the Lord. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts. Isaiah 55:8-9



WHAT GOD DIDN'T DO

God could have intervened to make Joseph's life less painful—but **HE DID NOT.**



- He could have resolved the sibling rivalry in Joseph's story.
 - He could have directed the Midianite traders not to buy Joseph.
 - He could have prevented the false accusation by Potiphar's wife.
 - He could have reminded the butler to tell the court about Joseph's interpretation—instead he forgot.

Each stage of the journey was a necessary part of the end. But in the middle of it all, Joseph couldn't see that. It wasn't until the very end that he could see it!

There is collateral goodness even in the painful experiences—we just need to look for it!
