
OUR CONDOLENCES...

But now his creditor is coming to take my two boys as his slaves." ² Elisha replied to her, "How can I help you? Tell me, what do you have in your house?" "Your servant has nothing there at all," she said, "except a small jar of olive oil." ³ Elisha said, "Go around and ask all your neighbors for empty jars. Don't ask for just a few. ⁴ Then go inside and shut the door behind you and your sons. Pour oil into all the jars, and as each is filled, put it to one side." ⁵ She left him and shut the door behind her and her sons. They brought the jars to her and she kept pouring. ⁶ When all the jars were full, she said to her son, "Bring me another one." But he replied, "There is not a jar left." Then the oil stopped flowing. ⁵ She went and told the man of God, and he said, "Go, sell the oil and pay your debts. You and your sons can live on what is left." 2 *Kings 4:1-7*

» The Background

- There were three Bible Schools in those days: at Bethel, Jericho, and Gilgal.
- The man who passed away was a student at one of those schools. Elisha likely knew him.
- The widow is desperate because the creditors want to make bondservants of his two sons to pay off the bills.
- She pleads her case to Elisha because he was God's representative.

- Elisha was stunned. He asks a question: "How can I help you?"
- He was sensitive; he was concerned; he was compassionate.
- Elisha asks another question: "What do you have in your house?" Her reply: : "I have nothing...except a little oil."
