Mighty God ('EL GIBÖR) — OR God-Warrior

The Hebrew translates: "God-Warrior," "Mighty Warrior," "God Mighty," and "Mighty Hero." Since 'el appears in the initial position, we are inclined to see it as a hyphenated form, "God-Warrior."

Who is this coming from Bozrah in Edom with clothes stained red? Who is this hero marching in his glorious uniform? "It's me, the LORD! I have won the battle, and I can save you!" Isaiah 63:1 CEV

The LORD is a warrior; The LORD is His name. Exodus 15:3

The Lord will march out like a champion, like a warrior he will stir up his zeal; with a shout he will raise the battle cry and will triumph over his enemies. Isaiah 42:13

The Lord your God is with you, the Mighty Warrior who saves. He will take great delight in you; in his love he will no longer rebuke you, but will rejoice over you with singing. Zephaniah 3:17

Who is this King of glory? The Lord strong and mighe Lord mighty in battle. Psalm 24:8

+ THE ULTIMATE VICTORY: The Cross

¹¹ In him you were also circumcised with a circumcision not performed by human hands. Your whole self ruled by the flesh was put off when you were circumcised by Christ, ¹² having been buried with him in baptism, in which you were also raised with him through your faith in the working of God, who raised him from the dead. ¹³ When you were dead in your sins and in the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made you alive with Christ. He forgave us all our sins, ¹⁴ having canceled the charge of our legal indebtedness, which stood against us and condemned us; he has taken it away, nailing it to the cross. ¹⁵ And having disarmed the powers and authorities, he made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them by the cross.

- · Salvation: He rescues us.
- · Revelation: He discloses Himself.
- · Conquest: He overcomes evil.

Through the victory of Calvary, hell's power is broken in the heavenlies. Now the Church is commissioned to extend that triumph to every land and to every person.



1. A PUBLIC DECLARATION OF YOUR COMMITTED LOVE OF JESUS

It is a symbolic picture of what happened when you received Jesus' offer of salvation and relationship. Receiving Jesus is entering into an exclusive and committed relationship. Baptism is the public identification of your relationship with Jesus.

2. AN ACT OF OBEDIENCE

Following in Jesus's example, and the directive of the Bible – Go and be baptized. All believers and followers of Jesus are commanded to be baptized.

Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Mt 28:19

Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. Acts 2:38

3. ONE OF THE TWO ORDINANCES OF THE CHURCH

Communion and baptism are the only 2 sacraments, or ordinances, to us to practice. It is an identification with Jesus' death, burial and resurrection.

4. AN ACT OF FAITH

When you came to Christ, you were "circumcised," but not by a physical procedure. It was a spiritual procedure—the cutting away of your sinful nature. For you were buried with Christ when you were baptized. And with him you were raised to a new life because you trusted the mighty power of God, who raised Christ from the dead. Colossians 2:11-12

5. THE GIFT OF A CLEAN CONSCIENCE

We all long for a clean fresh start when we become aware of what we have done wrong. Baptism provides a brand new start - we leave the old "me" in the water.
