REFLECTION

“We find thus by experience that there is no good applying to Heaven for earthly comfort. Heaven can give heavenly comfort; no other kind. And earth cannot give earthly comfort either. There is no earthly comfort in the long run. For the dream of finding our end, the thing we were made for, in a Heaven of purely human love could not be true unless our whole Faith were wrong. We were made for God. Only by being in some respect like Him, only by being a manifestation of His beauty, lovingkindness, wisdom, or goodness, has any earthly Beloved excited our love. It is not that we have loved them too much, but that we did not quite understand what we were loving. It is not that we shall be asked to turn from them, so dearly familiar, to a Stranger. When we see the face of God we shall know that we have always known it. He has been a party to, has made, sustained, and moved moment by moment within, all our earthly experiences of innocent love. All that was true love in them was, even on earth, far more His than ours, and ours only because His. In Heaven there will be no anguish and no duty of turning away from our earthly Beloveds. First, because we shall have turned already; from the portraits to the Original, from the rivulets to the Fountain, from the creatures He made lovable to Love Himself. But secondly, because we shall find them all in Him. By loving Him more than them we shall love them more than we now do.”

Faith & Repentance:

Please also use this as a time of reflection, application, and prayer.

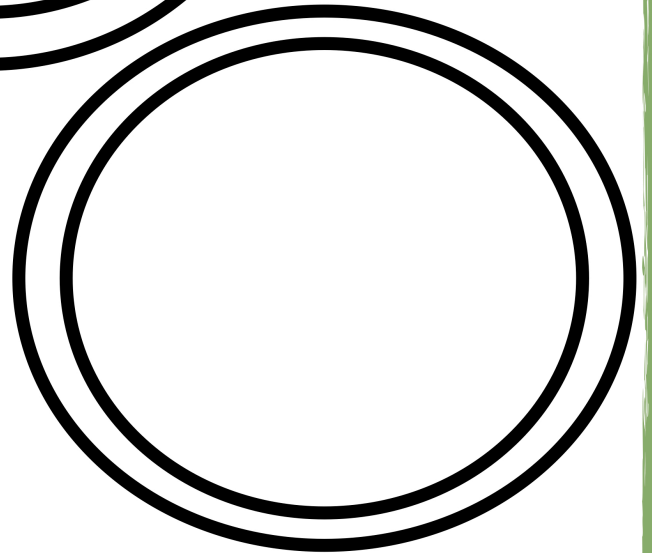
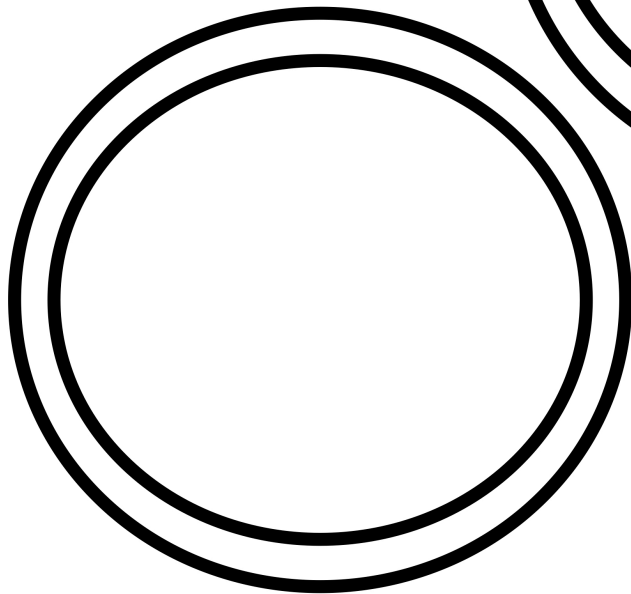
Baptism

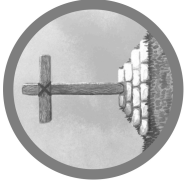

STORY

Jesus died and is alive again

SCRIPTURE

John 19:16b-20:31

MAIN IDEA

Jesus is alive!

AT HOME

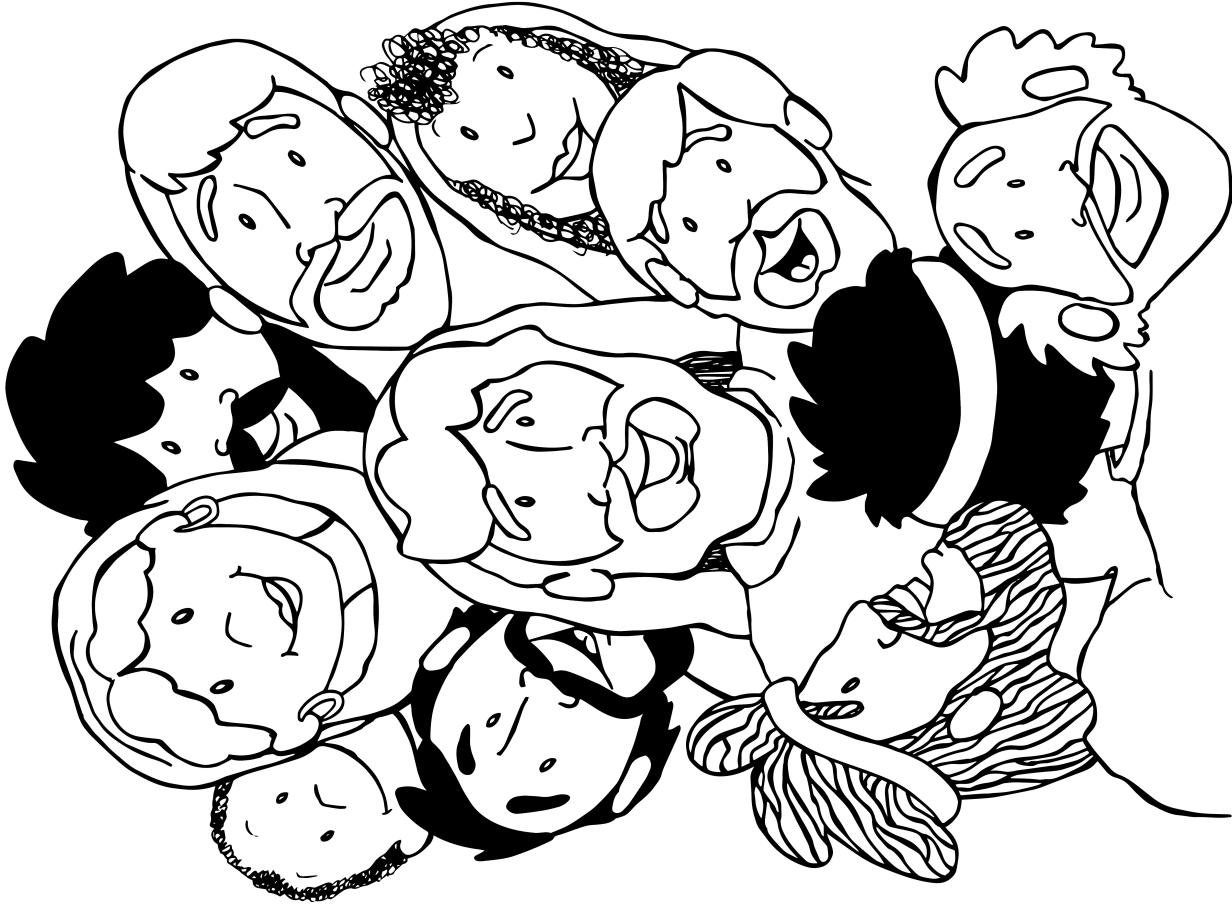
- Show pictures of Jesus on the cross. Talk about Him, showing sadness because Jesus is on the cross. Tell your child that Jesus had many owies and then Jesus didn't move or talk. Then tell your child that Jesus came back! Jesus could move and talk. Jesus is alive.
- Throughout the day, point out to your child things that are alive and things that are not alive. (You may want to stay with the simplest meaning possible. For example, "The dog can walk. The dog can lick my face. The dog is alive. The table can't walk. The table is not alive.")

PRAY

Thank Jesus for coming back. Praise Jesus that He is alive.

Work on memorizing this month's verse with your child.

Lesson 3





His Good Plan
