Ephesians 2:1-3

ASSURANCE OF PARDON

Ephesians 2:4-6

Faith & Repentance:

None is righteous, no, not one... for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God... For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord... if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved... For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved... For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life... And there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.

Please also use this as a time of reflection, application, and prayer.

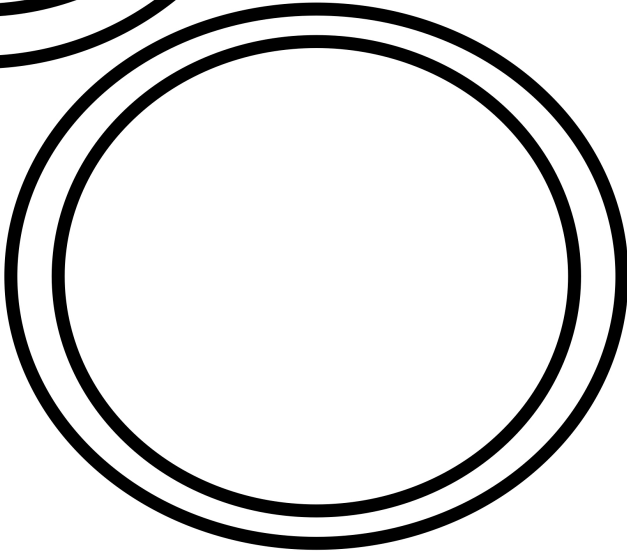
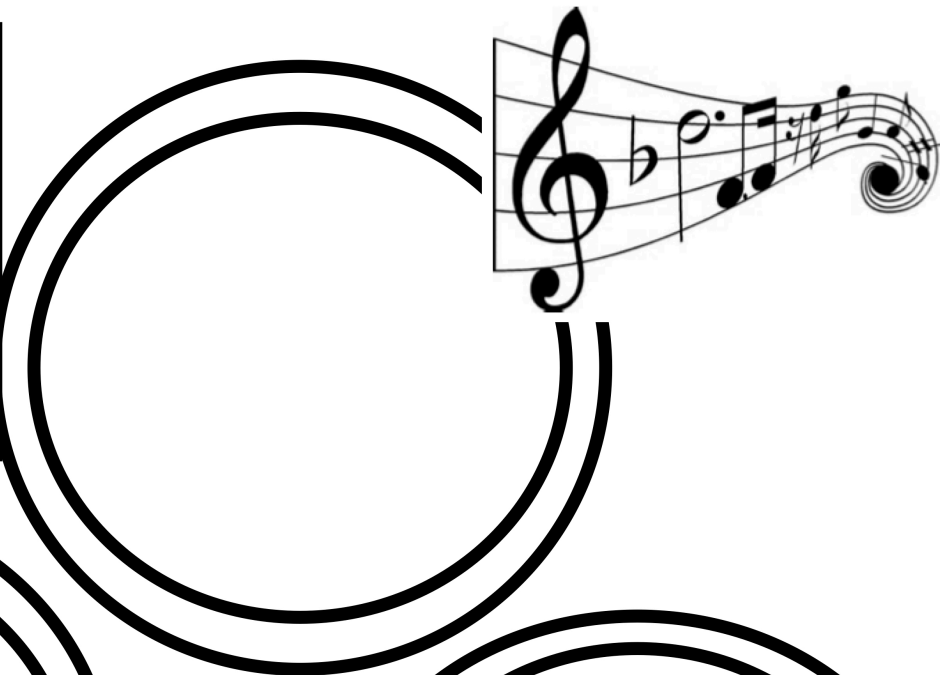
Baptism

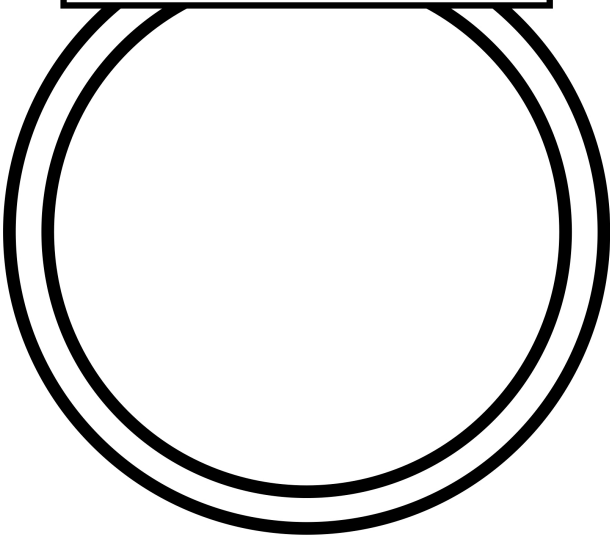

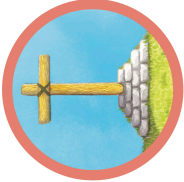

AT HOME

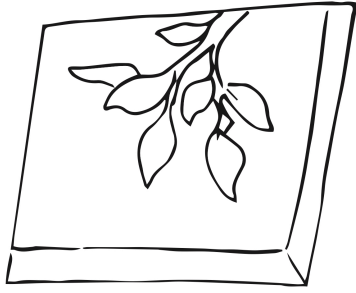
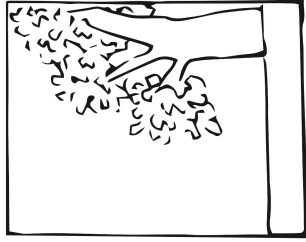
- Frequently point out to your child that Jesus is with us.
- Talk about the people who are not with you and remind your child that Jesus is always with us (e.g., Daddy's not with us; he is at work. Grandpa is not with us; he lives far away. But Jesus is with us! Jesus is always with us!).

PRAY

- Thank Jesus for being with us.
- Tell Him that we are happy He is with us.
