### REFLECTION

"Sometimes God strips you of success so that you can see what you really abide in. Sometimes He wants you to have nothing but Him so you can know that He really is enough. As Larry Crabb says, "You might never really know Jesus is all that you need until He is all that you have."

The extent to which you abide in Jesus is measured by your ability to be joyful in all circumstances. If your joy varies based on your succession, your job, or your relationships status, that means you aren't really abiding in Him—you're abiding in those things.

Whatever controls your joy is what you abide in. When God is not answering your prayers the way you'd like Him to, you need to press into the gospel. You need to anchor your soul in the compassion demonstrated at the cross and the power demonstrated at the resurrection."

### CONFESSION

Psalm 51:6-12

Behold, you delight in truth in the inward being, and you teach me wisdom in the secret heart. Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean; wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow. Let me hear joy and gladness; let the bones that you have broken rejoice. Hide your face from my sins, and blot out all my iniquities. Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me. Cast me not away from your presence, and take not your Holy Spirit from me. Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and uphold me with a willing spirit.

### **ASSURANCE OF PARDON**

Romans 6:5-6

For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we shall certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his. We know that our old self was crucified with him in order that the body of sin might be brought to nothing, so that we would no longer be enslaved to sin.

### Faith & Repentance:

None is righteous, no, not one... for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God... For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord... if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved... For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved... For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life... And there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.


