REFLECTION

"God is not simply a boss or sovereign who serves us only as long as we meet the conditions of good behavior. Rather, God is now a perfect Father to us, giving us the unchanging security that only a parent-child relationship can give. He delights in us, singing over us in joy (Zephaniah 3: 14–17). He will never leave or forsake us even if we fall or sin (Hebrews 13: 5; Hosea 11: 8). Why? Has he no standards? Yes, he is perfectly just and holy, but Jesus has fulfilled them for us. He has absorbed and paid our penalty, being pierced for our transgressions and crushed for our iniquities (Isaiah 53: 5–6). Therefore now God is not our judge but our Father who will never condemn us (Romans 8: 1)."

CONFESSION

Psalm 32:4-5

For day and night your hand was heavy upon me; my strength was dried up as by the heat of summer. I acknowledged my sin to you, and I did not cover my iniquity; I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the LORD," and you forgave the iniquity of my sin.

(Let's reflect on our need for a Savior and celebrate our abundance in Jesus.)

ASSURANCE OF PARDON

Psalm 32:1-2

Blessed is the one whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered. Blessed is the man against whom the LORD counts no iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no deceit.

Faith & Repentance:

None is righteous, no, not one... for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God... For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord... if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved... For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved... For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life... And there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.



Lesson 10

Jesus Is the Boss



The wind and the water obey Jesus

SCRIPTURE

Matthew 8:23-27

MAIN IDEA

Jesus is the boss.

AT HOME

- If you have pictures of Jesus in a Bible storybook, show them to your child. Make sure your child understands that Jesus grew up.
- Help your child to understand the word "obey." For example, "Mommy says, 'No.' Obey Mommy. Do what Mommy says."
- Talk to your child about bosses. Then remind him that Jesus is the boss of everything. For example, "Who is the boss of the house? Who is the boss at Daddy's work? Jesus is the boss of everything!"

PRAY

Praise Jesus for being the boss of everything.

MEMORY VERSE

Work on memorizing this month's verse with your child.

NOTE: The aim of this lesson is to lay a foundation for understanding the sovereignty of God. As your child is able to understand them, begin to use terms such as "in charge" or "in control" of everything to explain the sovereignty of God.




Safe in God's Care
