REFLECTION

"Perhaps by this point you are feeling overwhelmed. You are saying, "But who can honestly claim that Jesus is Lord over all their life? Who can say that their repentance ushered them into a life of perfection—with no inconsistencies?"

Not Peter, who, after walking with Jesus for three years, denied Him three times in the space of one evening. Peter continued to struggle with hypocrisy, cowardice, and racism even after being filled with the Holy Spirit and becoming one of Christianity's greatest preachers. His inconsistency got so bad at one point that Paul had to rebuke him publicly!

Not King David, the adulterer, murderer, and cover-up artist, who did all these things after he was called "the man after God's own heart" and writing a lot of those great Psalms.

Not Job, who lost his patience with God and had to be rebuked by Him for challenging His wisdom (Job 40: 1–5; 42: 1–6).

Not the disciples of Jesus who deserted Him at the hour of Jesus' trial...

If repentance were perfection, none of these people repented. Repentance, however, means recognizing Jesus' authority and submitting to it, even though you know your heart is weak, divided, and pulled in conflicting directions. Repentance includes a plea for God to change your inconsistent, divided heart (Ps. 86: 11; Mark 9: 24)."

Call to Worship: Our worship begins each week with a call to worship. We are gathered here today because God, our Creator, desires to have a relationship with us. It has been the practice of the church for thousands of years to have portions of the Bible read during worship services.

Confession & Assurance:

We confess together, in community, before a gracious God who has given us himself. Confession both acknowledges our need for mercy and celebrates its abundance in Christ. We are assured in the scriptures that our penalty was paid completely by Christ.

Baptism


If you are a Christian and haven't been baptized, please talk with an elder. We would be honored to baptize you.

We hope this time has been helpful to you as you consider your relationship with Jesus Christ and with his people, the church. Our pastors and elders are available for any questions you might have.




While worshipping this morning, who do you notice is leading us in singing, reading Scripture, or praying?

KALEO KIDS in the Gospel Project Unit 2: Creation Is Ruined
