

Call to Worship: Our worship begins each week with a call to worship. We are gathered here today because God, our Creator, desires to have a relationship with us. It has been the practice of the church for thousands of years to have portions of the Bible read during worship services.

We confess together, in community, before a gracious God who has given us himself. Confession both acknowledges our need for mercy and celebrates its abundance in Christ. We are assured in the scriptures that our penalty was paid completely by Christ.

CALL TO WORSHIP

Psalm 116:1-2

I love the LORD, because he has heard my voice and my pleas for mercy. **Because he inclined his ear** to me, therefore I will call on him as long as I live.

CONFESSION

Psalm 116:5-6

Gracious is the LORD, and righteous; our God is merciful. *The LORD preserves the simple;* when I was brought low, he saved me.

(Let's reflect on our need for a Savior and celebrate our abundance in Jesus.)

ASSURANCE OF PARDON

Psalm 116:8-9

For you have delivered my soul from death, my eyes from tears, my feet from stumbling; *I* will walk before the LORD in the land of the living.

Faith & Repentance:

None is righteous, no, not one... for all have sinned and fall short of the *glory of God... For* the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord... if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved... For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved... For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life... And there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.

(Romans 3:10, 23; 6:23; 10:9-10, 13. John 3:16. Acts 4:12.)
