REFLECT

"One of the few interesting statements uttered by (Tom) Brady came after Super Bowl number three... The interviewer asked Brady what he felt after winning pro football's ultimate prize, no doubt expecting him to say something along the elation-at-being-the-best or culmination-of-hard-work lines. Standard athlete stuff. Instead, Brady said something along the lines of "Is this all there is?" It was classic book-of-Ecclesiastes stuff, and for the first time I became interested in Brady other than simply being jealous of him and therefore wishing that he would get crushed... he gave voice to something that usually only comes out in private.. In Ecclesiastes 6: 1-2, the Teacher/ narrator expresses a similar sentiment when he writes: "I have seen another evil under the sun, and it weighs heavily on men: God gives a man wealth, possessions and honor, so that he lacks nothing his heart desires, but God does not enable him to enjoy them, and a stranger enjoys them instead. This is meaningless, a grievous evil." He goes on to write in verse 7: "All man's efforts are for his mouth, yet his appetite is never satisfied."
