



Children's Pastor - Job Description

Who are we looking for?

- **A Team Player/Leader:** Someone who can effectively recruit & train new team members (as needed) and who can lead an existing team while fostering an environment of friendship, service and integrity.
- **A Shepherd for our children and our families:** Effective children's ministry acknowledges that while we're certainly about the business of discipling children, we're also about the business of equipping parents to shape their children into Christ-likeness.
- **Maturity in Christ:** Someone with a teachable heart and a commitment to growth and learning.
- **Do you have to be Anglican?** Not necessarily! As long as you have a passion for spiritual formation and age-appropriate learning, we can work with that.

Main Duties Include:

- **K-5th Grade:** Organize and oversee Children's Sunday School, teaching as needed.
- **Nursery and Preschool:** Hire, train (as needed) and schedule paid caregivers to work in the nursery and preschool on Sunday mornings. *Note: this is our current practice, but these roles could also be filled by volunteers.*
- **Oversee, implement and coordinate standards, training and procedures on child safety** to ensure the physical, mental and emotional well-being of every child. Maintain safety training records and background checks for all volunteers and paid caregivers. (Examples: [MinistrySafe](#) or [Darkness to Light](#))
- **Curriculum:** [Godly Play](#) is our current preferred curriculum, but we're open to other thoughtful curricula that are sensitive to age-appropriate learning and spiritual formation.
- **Miscellany:** Participation in weekly staff meeting. Other duties as assigned
