Help us to be instruments of your peace and ministers of reconciliation.

Lift up your prayers for the world...

Mary treasured all of these things in her heart.

Open our eyes and hearts to see the wonders of Your love.

Lift up your thanksgivings to the Lord...

Confession

Let us confess our sins against God and our neighbor...

Have mercy upon us, most merciful Father; in Your compassion forgive us our sins, known and unknown, things done and left undone; and so uphold us by Your Spirit that we may live and serve You in newness of life, to the honor and glory of Your Name; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

During Epiphany:

We are invited to be part of the kingdom work of the restoration of all things. Let us approach God's throne of grace with confidence to offer prayers for the needs, concerns and hopes of the world.

Jesus, You are the way, the truth and the life.

Guide all who follow You, deepen our appreciation of Your truth and renew us with Your life.

Lift up your prayers for the Church...

Jesus, You are the light of the world.

Bring the light of Your Gospel to the ends of the earth. Please bring into Your kingdom those we now name.

Lift up by name those who need salvation in Jesus...

Almighty God, You are the King of kings and the whole earth is filled with Your glory.

Lead all nations to be instruments of Your freedom, justice and peace.

Lift up your prayers for our community, this nation and the world...

Lord, You are the Good Shepherd who gave your life for the sheep.

Bind up the injured, feed the hungry, strengthen the weak, bring home the rejected.

Lift up your prayers for all who are oppressed, in need, sorrow or sickness...

Lord, You are our blessing and our joy. We praise You for all the blessings of this life.

Make us faithful stewards of Your goodness.

Lift up your thanksgivings to the Lord...

Confession

Let us confess our sins against God and our neighbor...

Holy God, forgive us our sins: what we have done and what we have left undone. We have missed opportunities to love others, we have allowed fear and doubt to make us small in our faith. Remind us again of your presence with us and in us. Free us from guilt, shame, and self-doubt. Help us to live with integrity, to act courageously as your people, and to speak the love of God in all of our words and actions. Restore us; that we may delight in your will, and walk in your ways, to the glory of your Name. Amen.

Absolution

Almighty God, our heavenly Father, who in his great mercy has promised forgiveness of sins to all those who sincerely repent and with true faith turn to Him, have mercy upon you, pardon and deliver you from all your sins, confirm and strengthen you in all goodness, and bring you to everlasting life; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

The Liturgy of the Table - The Holy Eucharist

The Offertory

Yours, O Lord, is the greatness, and the power, and the glory, and the victory, and the majesty: for everything in heaven and on earth is yours; yours is the Kingdom, O Lord, and you are exalted as Head above all. All things come from you, O Lord!

And of your own have we given you.

Offertory and Doxology

The Sursum Corda

The Lord be with you.

It is right to give Him thanks and praise.

It is right, our duty and our joy, always and everywhere to give thanks to you, Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth.

Christmastide

Because you gave Jesus Christ, your only Son, to be born for us; who, by the working of the Holy Spirit, was made truly man, taking on the flesh of the Virgin Mary his mother; and yet without the stain of sin, to make us clean from sin.

Epiphany

Through Jesus Christ our Lord, who took on our mortal flesh to reveal His glory; that he might bring us out of darkness and into His own glorious light.

Therefore we praise you, joining our voices with Angels and Archangels and with all the company of heaven, who forever sing this hymn to proclaim the glory of your Name:

The Sanctus es Benedictus

Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might, heaven and earth are full of your glory. Hosanna in the highest! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest!

The Prayers of Consecration

Holy and gracious Father: In your infinite love you made us for yourself; and when we had sinned against you and become subject to evil and death, you, in your mercy, sent your only Son into the world for our salvation. By the Holy Spirit and the Virgin Mary he became flesh and dwelt among us. In obedience to Your will, he stretched out His arms upon the cross and offered Himself once for all, that by His suffering and death we might be saved. By His resurrection He broke the bonds of death, trampling Hell and Satan under his feet. As our great high priest, He ascended to your right hand in glory, that we might come with confidence before the throne of grace.

On the night that He was betrayed, our Lord Jesus Christ took bread; and when He had given thanks, He broke it, and gave it to His disciples, saying, "Take, eat; this is my Body which is given for you: Do this in remembrance of Me."

Likewise, after supper, Jesus took the cup, and when He had given thanks, He gave it to them, saying, "Drink this, all of you; for this is my Blood of the New Covenant, which is shed for you, and for many, for the forgiveness of sins: Whenever you drink it, do this in remembrance of Me."

Therefore we proclaim the mystery of faith:

Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again!

So we celebrate the memorial of our redemption, O Father, in this sacrifice of praise and thanksgiving. Send down Your Holy Spirit upon these gifts of your creation (+) and make this bread the holy body of Your Christ and this cup the precious blood of Your Christ. May your Holy Spirit also fall upon us (+), that we might be sanctified in body and soul and empowered to bring forth the fruit of good works. And bring us with all your saints into the fullness of your heavenly kingdom, where we shall see our Lord face to face. All this we ask through your Son Jesus Christ:

By him, and with him, and in him, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all honor and glory is yours, Almighty Father, now and forever. Amen.

And the blessing of God Almighty, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, be among you, and remain with you always. *Amen.*
