
Order of Worship November 24, 2019

Preparing Our Hearts: If you arrive a little early, prepare your heart for worship by reading and thinking about this text:

- *By the word of the LORD the heavens were made, and by the breath of his mouth all their host.* (Psalm 33:6 ESV)

Call to Worship:

- God calls us to worship
 - *Shout for joy in the LORD, O you righteous! Praise befits the upright. Give thanks to the LORD with the lyre; make melody to him with the harp of ten strings! Sing to him a new song; play skillfully on the strings, with loud shouts. For the word of the LORD is upright, and all his work is done in faithfulness.* (Psalm 33:1–4 ESV)
- We humbly respond with praise
 - Congregational Song: “Open the Eyes of My Heart”
 - Congregational Song: “Better Is One Day”

Gospel Assurance:

- Our need for Jesus
 - Congregational Song: “All I Have Is Christ”
- God’s grace
 - *Therefore, holy brothers, you who share in a heavenly calling, consider Jesus, the apostle and high priest of our confession, who was faithful to him who appointed him, just as Moses also was faithful in all God’s house. For Jesus has been counted worthy of more glory than Moses—as much more glory as the builder of a house has more honor than the house itself. (For every house is built by someone, but the builder of all things is God.) Now Moses was faithful in all God’s house as a servant, to testify to the things that were to be spoken later, but Christ is faithful over God’s house as a son. And we are his house, if indeed we hold fast our confidence and our boasting in our hope.* (Hebrews 3:1–6 ESV)
 - Congregational Song: “The Solid Rock”

What We Believe: As a church we want to affirm our unity in what we believe.

- *We believe the Lord will swallow up death forever; and the Lord GOD will wipe away tears from all faces, and the reproach of his people he will take away from all the earth, for the LORD has spoken.* (Isaiah 25:8 ESV)

Prayer: We bring our requests to the Lord through Jesus Christ.

Church Life/Greeting: In Christ, we live and fellowship together as believers. We take time to learn what is going on in our church, and to greet one another as we worship.

Prayer for Understanding: We pray that God will open our hearts and minds to the preaching of His Word.

Sermon:

- Exodus 6:2-30

Lord's Supper: In taking communion together, we remember the death of Christ as we proclaim it to one another as we consume the elements.

- Congregational Song: "Before the Throne"

Praise to God (Doxology): We end our time of worship together as we resound in praises together.

- Congregational Song: "Redeemed, Restored, Forgiven"

God Blesses: We go into the world this week with God's blessings as He enables us to serve Him.

- *And after you have suffered a little while, the God of all grace, who has called you to his eternal glory in Christ, will himself restore, confirm, strengthen, and establish you. To him be the dominion forever and ever. Amen. (1 Peter 5:10–11 ESV)*
