## Order of Worship December 29, 2019

Preparing Our Hearts: If you arrive a little early, prepare your heart for worship by reading and thinking about this text:

- *You who fear the LORD, trust in the LORD! He is their help and their shield. (Psalm 115:11 ESV)*

Call to Worship:

- God calls us to worship
  - *Not to us, O LORD, not to us, but to your name give glory, for the sake of your steadfast love and your faithfulness! Why should the nations say, "Where is their God?" Our God is in the heavens; he does all that he pleases. (Psalm 115:1–3 ESV)*
- We humbly respond with praise
  - Congregational Song: "Not to Us"
  - Congregational Song: "As the Deer"

Gospel Assurance:

- Our need for Jesus
  - *O Lord, open my lips, and my mouth will declare your praise. For you will not delight in sacrifice, or I would give it; you will not be pleased with a burnt offering. The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise. (Psalm 51:15–17 ESV)*
  - Silent Confession
- God's grace
  - *If you, O LORD, should mark iniquities, O Lord, who could stand? But with you there is forgiveness, that you may be feared. I wait for the LORD, my soul waits, and in his word I hope; my soul waits for the Lord more than watchmen for the morning, more than watchmen for the morning. (Psalm 130:3–6 ESV)*
  - Congregational Song: "I Come Running"

What We Believe: As a church we want to affirm our unity in what we believe.

- Congregational Song: "Because We Believe"

Prayer: We bring our requests to the Lord through Jesus Christ.

Church Life/Greeting: In Christ, we live and fellowship together as believers. We take time to learn what is going on in our church, and to greet one another as we worship.

Prayer for Understanding: We pray that God will open our hearts and minds to the preaching of His Word.

Sermon:

- Exodus 11:1-10

Lord's Supper: In taking communion together, we remember the death of Christ as we proclaim it to one another as we consume the elements.

- Congregational Song: "Hallelujah What a Savior"

Praise to God (Doxology): We end our time of worship together as we resound in praises together.

- Congregational Song: "How Great Is Our God"

God Blesses: We go into the world this week with God's blessings as He enables us to serve Him.

- *To him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood and made us a kingdom, priests to his God and Father, to him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.*  
(Revelation 1:5-6 ESV)
