

Order of Worship February 21, 2021

Call to worship:

- God calls us to worship:
 - *For who in the skies can be compared to the LORD? Who among the heavenly beings is like the LORD, a God greatly to be feared in the council of the holy ones, and awesome above all who are around him? O LORD God of hosts, who is mighty as you are, O LORD, with your faithfulness all around you?* (Psalm 89:6–8 ESV)

Our Need for Jesus:

We are reminded of our need for Jesus, and God’s grace through Christ:

The spiritual person judges all things, but is himself to be judged by no one. “For who has understood the mind of the Lord so as to instruct him?” But we have the mind of Christ.* (1 Corinthians 2:14–16 ESV)
