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WEEK 1:

THE GOSPELS

Who is God's Son? (*Jesus*) Who can do amazing things? (*Jesus*)

WEEK 2:

Jesus dies and comes back. Then He visits His friends so they can see that He is alive. MATTHEW 26–28; JOHN 21:1-14 Who showed us how to love others? (Jesus) Who is alive? (Jesus)

WEEK 3:

Paul has a life-changing encounter with Jesus that makes him believe that Jesus is alive.

ACTS 9:1-20

What is the new rule Jesus gave us? (Love everyone) Who went from angry to happy when they met Jesus? (Paul)

WEEK 4:

Peter tells everyone, everywhere that Jesus is alive, He loves them, and wants to be their friend forever.

ACTS 10

Who can we can tell about Jesus? (*Everyone*) Where can we tell people about Jesus? (*Everywhere*)
