THIS PSALM OF ASCENT IS A COMMUNAL SONG OF CONFIDENCE AND A COMMUNAL LAMENT."

- 5. Is there a warning in this psalm? If so, what is that warning? Why is that warning important?
- 6. It has been said that "the good in us is God in us." Do you agree with this statement? Why or why not? Does this psalm seem to imply that this statement is true or that the statement is false?
- 7. Is there anything else that stands out to you in this psalm that you would like to discuss?

PSALM 125 {ESV}

1 THOSE WHO TRUST IN THE LORD ARE LIKE MOUNT ZION, WHICH CANNOT BE MOVED, BUT ABIDES FOREVER.

2 AS THE MOUNTAINS SURROUND
JERUSALEM, SO THE LORD SURROUNDS HIS
PEOPLE, FROM THIS TIME FORTH AND
FOREVERMORE.

3 FOR THE SCEPTER OF WICKEDNESS SHALL NOT REST ON THE LAND ALLOTTED TO THE RIGHTEOUS, LEST THE RIGHTEOUS STRETCH OUT THEIR HANDS TO DO WRONG.

4 DO GOOD, O LORD, TO THOSE WHO ARE GOOD, AND TO THOSE WHO ARE UPRIGHT IN THEIR HEARTS!

5 BUT THOSE WHO TURN ASIDE TO THEIR CROOKED WAYS THE LORD WILL LEAD AWAY WITH EVILDOERS! PEACE BE UPON ISRAEL!
