Chapter 5: Who among the gods, is like You, O LORD?

Questions to consider and discuss:

1. Karl Barth says “the triunity of God is the secret of God’s beauty.” How would you explain God’s character/attributes with a trinitarian emphasis? (e.g.) God as merciful (pg. 112) or God’s majesty (pg. 113) or God’s Holiness or God’s wrath.
2. On page 118, Reeves says, God is angry at evil because He loves. Is this statement true or helpful, why, or why not?
3. The author talks about what it means to glorify God. He says that since God is “already superabundant and overflowing with life” to glorify God is to “ascribe to God what is already God’s.” Do you think of God’s glory in this way? What about when Ezekiel speaks of God’s glory as a person and a light? How would you describe the Glory of God?
4. How is Jesus the embodiment of the radiance of God? (pg. 125-127) Where does Calvin say the God’s glory shines the brightest?
