Becoming Who We Are, Part 3

“Christ the Cornerstone”

Ephesians 2:11-22

- Ice Breaker – Play two truths and a lie (breakout if necessary for time).
- Have one or two people share their SOAP Devotion for today’s text.

### FROM-THE-SERMON

- 1) Read Ephesians 2:11-22 together. What is one observation you have about the text?
- 2) What did it cost Christ to say yes to the Father? What was the result of His yes? (v13)
- 3) What does Paul’s use of the word *ktizo* (to create something out of nothing as in God creates) in verse 15 show about Christ?
- 4) What are the ensuing identities of people thanks to Christ, and what are the implications of each? (v18-21)

### BEYOND-THE-SERMON

- 5) What are some misconceptions we have about Christ – or, how high is our view of Christ in our hearts? How does it affect the way we live as citizens, saints, and family of God?
- 6) Is there anything you have recently said ‘yes’ to God about? What has your experience been like? Is God asking you to say ‘yes’ to something currently? What would that look like?
