





GET-TO-KNOW

Ice Breaker – What is the biggest commitment you've ever made so far in your life, and how did it change your life?

FROM THE SERMON

- 1) Read John 1:35-51 together. What are some observations and/or questions you have about the text?
- 2) What were the two disciples of John the Baptist seeking, and how did Jesus respond? How are they shaped by Jesus' words later on in the passage?
- 3) How does this passage shape our view of evangelism and what it means to share our faith with others?
- 4) How do the ideas that Jesus invites us to come and see and abide with him, and that he has drawn near as the presence of God impact your faith and relationship with God?

BEYOND THE SERMON

- 5) How can you grow in your understanding and relationship with Jesus?
- 6) What are some areas in your life that God is speaking to you about, and how can you better respond to him?

List of Questions to help with stories in the Book of John

- 1. What is the central idea of the plot structure?
- What is the author's topic? · What is the author saying about that topic?
- 2. What are the characters, characterizations, and setting of this story?
- Characters and Characterization
- Setting: Time & Place
- 3. What is the function of this story in the larger framework of John?
- How does the particular story I'm looking at relate and function within the larger framework of the story that John's telling?
- 4. What are the key terms in this story?
- Identify key terms within the story that calls for more clarification or elaboration.
- What are the key terms (Word Studies) used here?
- What is their significance?
- 5. What historical-cultural background will help us understand this story?
- 6. What are the theological ideas that emerge from this story?
- What do we learn about God? About Christ? About us, humanity? About sin?
- 7. What difference does this story make in my world today?
- After doing all the work on the other questions:
- How am I different from what I just learned?
- It's the "so what?"
- What difference does it make at all in the real world? What does this story's message have to say about how I live in this world, in my world today?
