

4. We were a slave to sin: Reflecting on the concept of being a "slave to sin," what aspects of your life have you felt enslaved to? How has recognizing these areas led you to seek freedom in Christ? (v. 8:31-34)

5. We were outside the family: The passage emphasizes that physical heritage or lineage doesn't automatically equate to spiritual belonging. How has your understanding of being part of God's family evolved since you became a believer? (V. 8:37-40)
