

Safety

What is your mask policy?

All kids and staff will be expected to wear a mask at all times, regardless of vaccination status, with the exception of staff while they are speaking on stage.

What if my child takes off their mask during the service?

If your child cannot keep their mask on or follow distancing rules after two reminders, you will be notified to pick up your child.

What if my child will not wear a mask?

For the safety of everyone involved, if your child does not or will not wear a mask, we invite you to participate in the Little Kids' live-stream, which will happen online at the same time as the in-person service at kkj.online.church.

Safety

How will you keep kids distanced?

In the large group of 20 kids, colored dots will be placed 6' apart on the floor for each child to sit. Kids will be distanced a minimum of 12' from anyone speaking on the stage. Additionally, staff will maintain distance and be as contact-free as is feasible.

Why are staff on stage without masks on?

If you see more than one person unmasked on stage at the same time, it will be because they are fully vaccinated.

How will small groups work?

Kids will sit distanced with their small groups in accordance with current CDPH guidelines.

Will you sanitize rooms?

Shared surfaces will be wiped periodically throughout the service.

What to expect

Timeline

When and where will in-person services for Living Hope Little Kids (LHLK) begin?
Our first Sunday will be on May 16, 2021, in Chapel 1.

What time will service be?

There will be one service every Sunday at 9:30 a.m., happening in-person and live-streamed concurrently.

Who can attend?

Children ages 3 to 5 are welcome to attend the Little Kids service; attendance is limited to 20 children.

What will a Sunday service look like?

Service will begin promptly at 9:30 with praise and a sermon. Kids will then meet in small groups with a teacher.

Will the personal greetings remain?

Yes! Greetings will continue both in-person and online.

Logistics

Does my child have to be pre-registered?

Pre-registration [include link] confirms your child's spot and is strongly encouraged. Walk-ins will be taken if capacity has not yet been met. If capacity has been met, unregistered children will join the adult service with their parent/guardian.

How many children are allowed to attend?

In accordance with CDPH guidelines, the current cap is 20 children due to decreased room capacity for indoor use and to maintain a safe teacher-to-student ratio.

Where is drop-off and pick-up?

Kids can be dropped off at Chapel 1 and picked up in the LH Little Kids hallway. If you have older kids in LH Kids, please pick up your Little Kids first and then proceed to the LH Kids pick-up area.

What is your restroom policy?

Children will be escorted to the entrance of the restroom by designated staff but they will be expected to use the restroom and wash their hands completely on their own.

What if my child needs a diaper change?

Parents will be notified if a diaper change is needed; staff will not be changing diapers.

Logistics

Is there a crying or holding policy?

If your child cries for 10 minutes or more, parents will be contacted to pick up your child.
Will there be snacks?

Will there be snacks?

There will not be snacks as masks are expected to be worn at all times. We will offer a packaged snack to take home at the end of service. Please bring a labeled water bottle for your child.

Will kids be sharing toys?

Play time will be facilitated by staff; toys will be sanitized after use and hand sanitizer will be readily available.

Staffing

Who will be on staff?

Staff will consist of Ms. Joohee, Ms. Julie, a group of coordinators, and volunteers aged 16 and up.

Are staff members vaccinated?

Many are, but not all. We cannot disclose this information due to privacy.
