Open Cry Room Guidelines

What is an open cry room?

- This is an available space (in the 0-1 room) where parents of young children (23 months and under) can watch & listen to the worship service together with their child.
- A parent must look after their own child during this time.
- There will only be 1 staff member supervising the cry room during 9:30am service, but not directly supervising the children. There will be no staff supervision during 11:30am service
- Diaper changing areas are available
- Nursing area is available

Who can use this room?

- This room is only for 0 -1 yr olds (newborn - 23 months old). Any child 2 years and older should participate in our Little Kids service.
- You must look after your own child.
- Only 1 parent per child is allowed in the room.
- Please do not use the room if you or your child are sick, have COVID-symptoms, or are waiting for COVID testing results.

When will the room be available?

- 9:30am & 11:30am service

Wearing a face mask is

- required for all adults
- optional for children 23 months and under

What else do I need to know?

- Please clean up after use and put toys/items back in their place.
- You may bring your own snacks for your child.
- Please clean up after your child when they are eating snacks in the room.
- Please be respectful of the noise level, as the purpose of this room is to allow for parents of young children to participate in service.
- No shoes or strollers inside the room. Car seats are allowed
- Use of the room is at the discretion of each parent.
