CELL GROUP DISCUSSIONS

The following are discussion questions based off of the sermon on March 1, 2020.

GET-TO-KNOW

1. Everyone experiences peaks (victories) and valleys (failures) of life. In smaller groups of two or three's, share a peak and a valley from your life.

FROM THE SERMON

We find Peter progressing from the Mountain to the Garden to the Fire. Have each person take a passage of their choice. Take a few minutes to individually read and study the passage again and be ready to answer the following questions about the passage:

- a) What does Peter's action reveal about who Peter is and whom he believed Jesus to be.
 - b) Which of the Peter's can you relate to the most? Why?
2. Peter at the Mountain (Mark 14:26-31)

 3. Peter in the Garden (Mark 14:32-42)

 4. Peter by the Fire (Mark 14:66-72)

BEYOND THE SERMON (perhaps in smaller groups)

The speaker emphasized that Peter's failure by the fire most prepared him to better receive the gospel and proclaim the gospel.

5. In smaller groups, share what valleys or failures have prepared you or can prepare you to receive the gospel calling. Take time to pray for one another.
