

THE PINNACLE OF CREATION

REST: GOAL OF CREATION

- Genesis 1:1
 - In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth
- The Bible stresses that God is pleased with what he has made.
 - Genesis 1:31

- He is the rightful king over everything he has made
 - The only proper response is worship (Ps. 95:3-7)

- Image of God
 - Genesis 1:27
- We are God's stewards, entrusted with the care of his precious creation.
- Sabbath is the climax of his creation
 - Genesis 2:1-3
- God and all of his creation lives in a continuing Sabbath, the seventh day

Genesis 1:27, 31, 2:1-3

²⁷ So God created man in his own image; in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them.

And God saw everything that he had made, and behold, it was very good. And there was evening and there was morning, the sixth day.

2 Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all the host of them. ² And on the seventh day God finished his work that he had done, and he rested on the seventh day from all his work that he had done. ³ So God blessed the seventh day and made it holy, because on it God rested from all his work that he had done in creation.

PERFECT RELATIONSHIP



God and human beings (Gen. 2:17)

• God is lovingly concerned for Adam. He gives him a wonderful environment to live in and provides the perfect partner for him (v18, 22). God is their loving ruler. He gives them great freedom (v16), but issue one prohibition, which is for their good (v17).

Man and women (Gen. 2:25)

• They enjoy complete intimacy without fear or guilt (v25)

Human beings and creation (Gen 2:15)

• They are to 'work' the 'Garden of Eden' and 'take care of it' (v15)

Genesis 2:15-25

¹⁵ The LORD God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to work it and keep it. ¹⁶ And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, "You may surely eat of every tree of the garden, ¹⁷ but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die."

²⁵ And the man and his wife were both naked and were not ashamed.

Men and women

- They cover themselves (v7). The complete openness and intimacy of 2:25 has gone.
- Adam blames Eve (v12)
- V16b seems to describe a power struggle. 'Desire', is used in 4:7 to speak of sins 'desire' to master Cain. It seems it refers in 3:16 to Eve's desire to dominate Adam, but he resists and seeks to 'rule' her.

Human beings and creation

• "cursed is the ground because of you" (v17). Works is a good part of God's creation (see 1:28; 2:15), but it will always involve frustration in a fallen world.

Human beings and God

 They are ashamed and hide from God (v8-10). They are banished from God and therefore from eternal life.
 'cherubim' (v24) are winged lions with human heads. They appear elsewhere in the Bible as the guardians of holy places.

3 Now the serpent was more crafty than any other beast of the field that the LORD God had made. He said to the woman, "Did God actually say, 'You^[a] shall not eat of any tree in the garden'?" ² And the woman said to the serpent, "We may eat of the fruit of the trees in the garden, 3 but God said, You shall not eat of the fruit of the tree that is in the midst of the garden, neither shall you touch it, lest you die." 4 But the serpent said to the woman, "You will not surely die. 5 For God knows that when you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil." 6 So when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was a delight to the eyes, and that the tree was to be desired to make one wise, she took of its fruit and ate, and she also gave some to her husband who was with her, and he ate. ⁷Then the eyes of both were opened, and they knew that they were naked. And they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves loincloths.

⁸ And they heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and the man and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God among the trees of the garden. 9 But the LORD God called to the man and said to him, "Where are you?" ¹⁰ And he said, "I heard the sound of you in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked, and I hid myself." II He said, "Who told you that you were naked? Have you eaten of the tree of which I commanded you not to eat?" 12 The man said, "The woman whom you gave to be with me, she gave me fruit of the tree, and I ate." 13 Then the LORD God said to the woman, "What is this that you have done?" The woman said, "The serpent deceived me, and I ate."

14 The LORD God said to the serpent, "Because you have done this, cursed are you above all livestock and above all beasts of the field; on your belly you shall go, and dust you shall eat all the days of your life. ¹⁵ I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and her offspring; he shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise his heel."

"I will surely multiply your pain in childbearing; in pain you shall bring forth children. Your desire shall be contrary to your husband, but he shall rule over you."

¹⁷ And to Adam he said. "Because you have listened to the voice of your wife and have eaten of the tree of which I commanded you, 'You shall not eat of it,' cursed is the ground because of you; in pain you shall eat of it all the days of your life; 18 thorns and thistles it shall bring forth for you; and you shall eat the plants of the field. 19 By the sweat of your face you shall eat bread, till you return to the ground, for out of it you were taken; for you are dust, and to dust you shall return."

- **JUDGES:** A Cycle of Sin and Grace
 - The cycle: **Jud 3: 7-11**
 - The problem: 'In those days Israel had no king' Jud 21:25
- I SAMUEL: A False Start
 - 'Appoint a king to leads us, such as all the other nations have' ISam 8:5
 - Saul anointed... and rejected...David anointed... and forced to flee
 - King's suffering and rejection before glory
- 2 **SAMUEL:** The Reign of David
 - Still one greater to come 2 Sam 7: 11b- 16
 - Son of David and Son of God
- I KINGS I-II: Solomon and the Golden Age
 - Promises fulfilled I Kings 8:56
 - The king turns from God

And the people of Israel served Cushan-rishathaim eight years. 9 But when the people of Israel cried out to the LORD, the LORD raised up a deliverer for the people of Israel, who saved them, Othniel the son of Kenaz, Caleb's younger brother. 10 The Spirit of the LORD was upon him, and he judged Israel. - Kingdom destroyed by Assyrians 722BC 2

- Corruption and compromise
- Defeated by Babylonians and exiled 597 and 586 BC 2 Ki 25







 - JESUS RETURNS



PENTACOST

- Preaching in other tongues/languages: a reversal of Babel
- A fulfilment of **Joel 2: 28-32**
- The age of the Spirit
 - **OT** lived only in special individuals for certain tasks
 - Now fills all God's people for empowering witness
- The spread of the gospel in Acts:
 - Jerusalem Judea Ends of the World


