Resurrection Power

But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ – by grace you have been saved – and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus (Ephesians 2:4-6).

Do you realize that one of the realities of Christ's resurrection is that the believer, through their union with Him, is now raised with Jesus and placed in the heavenly places. Positionally, our life is now considered to be with Christ in heaven. Do you recognize the power that this reality gives you now in this life?

And what is this power to be used for? It is to be used to partner with Christ in His mission of bringing the gospel to the nations for His glory. For us, that mission, that resurrection power, begins right here in Lake Oconee. What does this mean practically? According to C. John Miller, in his book *Outgrowing the Ingrown Church*, "We need to personalize the biblical teaching about Christ's atoning death for people in "darkness," His subsequent exaltation by resurrection and ascension, and the giving of the Great Commission. I must see that the risen Lord has told me personally to go and disciple the nations for His glory. He also assures me that the power for doing this issues from the majesty of His authority. To accomplish His missionary will, Christ also gives me His Spirit as the enabling power for taking the gospel to all the nations."

If this is true (and it is) and we have been raised with Christ, given His Spirit as our enabling power, obviously just doing church is not an option. Or at least not an obedient option. We have been given a commission by our risen, glorified Lord to disciple Lake Oconee, to be His instrument in bringing healing, renewal, and peace to our area, and we have also been given the enabling power to accomplish this. We do not do this on our own, in our own strength. This is Christ's promise. The only question is do we really believe this?

And here is one other exciting thing. This not something that any one of us does all by ourselves. It is the job of the entire church. This is why it is so exciting that we now have Mike, Travis, Ellen, our session, and leaders here to help equip all of us to do this work of discipling together for the glory of God. It is an adventure that we are all on together. Let's commit to not simply doing church, but to live in resurrection power bringing resurrection power to Lake Oconee and the nations for God's glory.
