FAMILY WORSHIP HELPS

Question: *Wherein consists Christ's exaltation?*

Answer: *Christ's exaltation consisted in His rising again from the dead on the third day, in ascending up into heaven, in sitting at the right hand of God the Father, and in coming to judge the world at the last day.*

Key Thought: The exaltation of Christ is seen in His resurrection.

Tuesday: Scripture: Mark 16:19-20; Acts 1:1-9; John 14:1-3
Key Thought: The exaltation of Christ is seen in His ascension.

Wednesday: Scripture: Ephesians 1:15-23
Key Thought: The exaltation of Christ is seen in His coronation.

Key Thought: The exaltation of Christ is seen in His promised return.

Friday: Scripture: Philippians 2:1-16; 1 Peter 5:5-7
Key Thought: The humiliation and exaltation of Christ is our model.

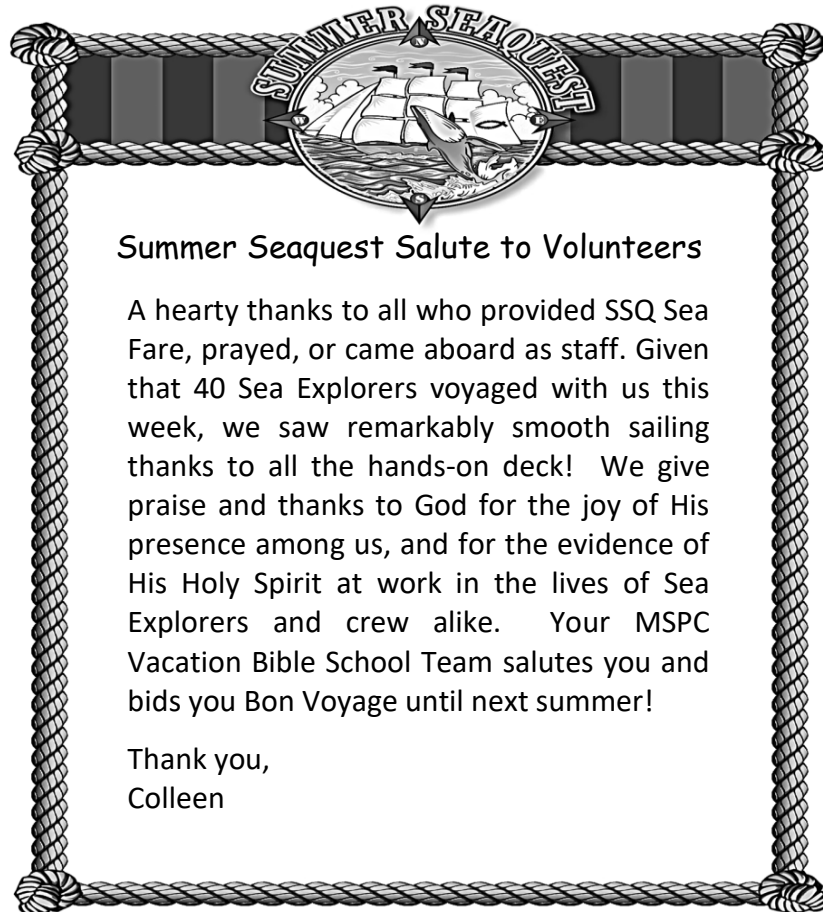
