Mutual Dependency

FAMILY WORSHIP HELPS

Question: *What benefits do believers receive from Christ at death?*

Answer: *The souls of believers are at their death made perfect in holiness and do immediately pass into glory; their bodies, being still united in Christ, do rest in their graves until the resurrection.*

Monday: Scripture: Philippians 1:19-26
Key Thought: For the believer, death is gain.

Tuesday: Scripture: Isaiah 57:1-2; 1 John 3:1-3
Key Thought: At death, believers are made perfect in holiness.

Wednesday: Scripture: Luke 23:39-43; Hebrews 12:22-24
Key Thought: At death, believers immediately pass into glory.

Thursday: Scripture: Job 19:23-27; 1 Corinthians 15:35-46
Key Thought: The bodies of believers rest in Christ until the resurrection.

Key Thought: All will one day be raised either to gain or loss.
