FAMILY WORSHIP HELPS

Question: *How is the Sabbath to be sanctified?*

Answer: *The Sabbath is to be sanctified by a holy resting all that day, even from such worldly employments and recreations as are lawful on other days; and spending the whole time in the public and private exercises of God's worship, except so much as is to be taken up in the works of necessity and mercy.*

Monday: Scripture: Amos 8:1-14
Key Thought: The Sabbath is a whole day of holy resting.

Tuesday: Scripture: Nehemiah 13:15-17; Isaiah 58:13-14
Key Thought: The Sabbath is a day to rest from worldly employments and recreations.

Wednesday: Scripture: Psalm 92:1-15
Key Thought: The Sabbath is a day for private and public worship.

Thursday: Scripture: Matthew 12:1-8; Luke 23:50-56
Key Thought: Works of necessity may be done on the Lord's Day.

Friday: Scripture: Matthew 12:9-15
Key Thought: Works of mercy may be done on the Lord's Day.
