## FAMILY WORSHIP HELPS

**Question:** Which day of the seven hath God appointed to be the weekly Sabbath?

**Answer:** From the beginning of the world to the resurrection of Christ, God appointed the seventh day of the week to be the weekly Sabbath; and the first day of the week ever since, to continue to the end of the world, which is the Christian Sabbath.

**Monday:** Scripture: Genesis 2:1-3; Exodus 20:8-11  
Key Thought: The seventh day was the original Sabbath.

**Tuesday:** Scripture: Leviticus 9:1-24  
Key Thought: The Old Testament anticipates a change to the first day.

**Wednesday:** Scripture: Psalm 118:14-24; Acts 4:10-11  
Key Thought: Christ established the new covenant Sabbath.

**Thursday:** Scripture: Mark 16:2; John 20:19-26; Acts 20:7; 1 Corinthians 16:1-2  
Key Thought: The apostles and the early Church recognized the change.

**Friday:** Scripture: Revelation 1:8-20  
Key Thought: The first day is the Lord's Day to the end of the world.
